

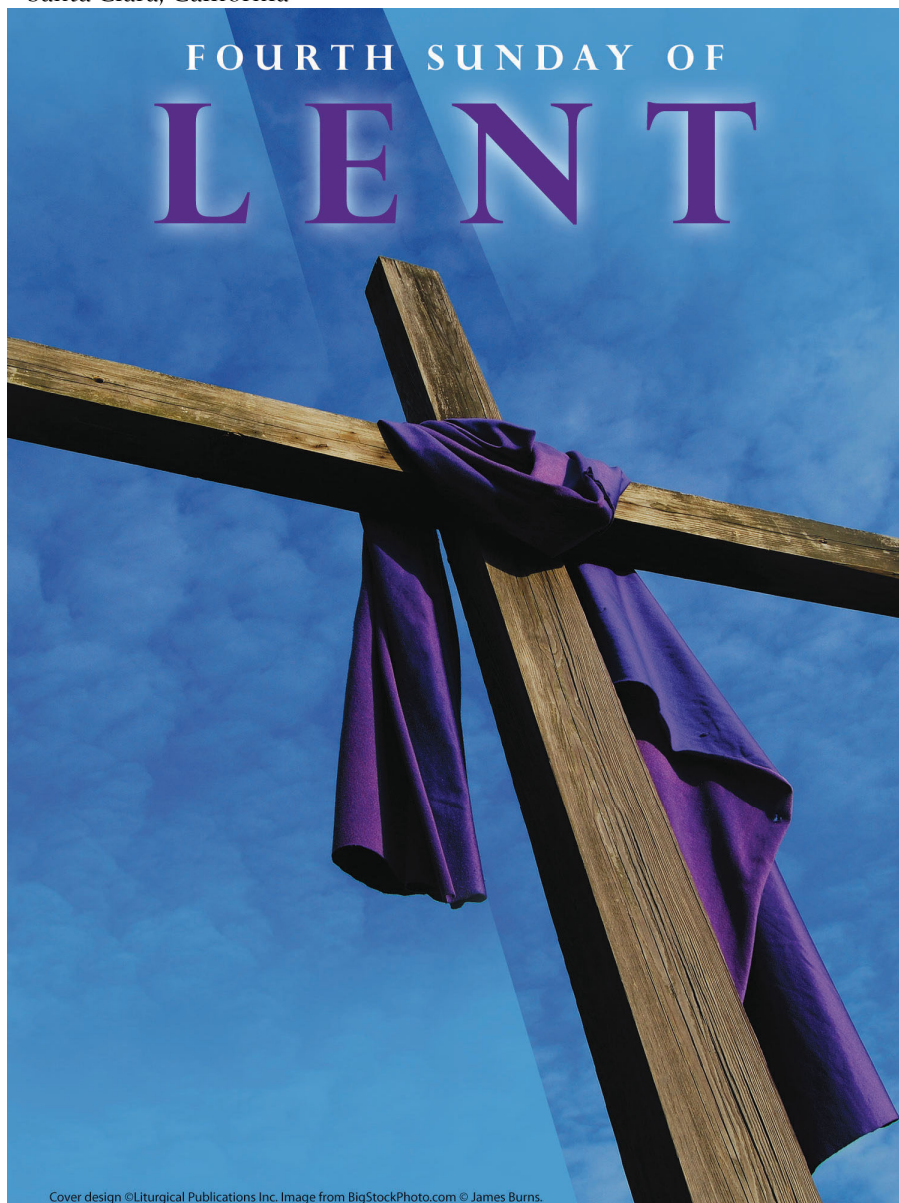

## **From Monsignor Fran Cilia**

---

The fifteenth chapter of the Gospel of Saint Luke is filled with stories of God's relentless love. This is most particularly true of the gospel story we hear this Sunday. "The Prodigal Son" tells of the richness of God's mercy, forgiveness and love. In fact, it may be more correctly titled as "The Parable of the Loving Father."

Some of us may mistakenly think that "prodigal" refers the repentant son when he decides to return to his father; however, "prodigal" actually describes the way the young man squandered his father's wealth.

The elder son could only focus on his brother's misdeeds and had no room for forgiveness in his heart. His bitterness seems never to have gone away and he remains alienated from his brother and his father, in spite of his father's pleading, "My son, you are here with me always; everything I have is yours. But now we must celebrate and rejoice, because your brother was dead and has come to life again; he was lost and has been found."

On this Fourth Sunday of Lent, may each of us not only experience a love that is like that of the father in this parable, but let us also extend that forgiving love to one another.

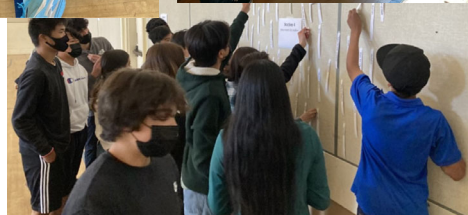

**Creation Care Tips**

*“On the day after the Passover, on that very day, they ate the produce of the land, unleavened cakes and parched grain. The manna ceased on the day they ate the produce of the land, and the Israelites no longer had manna; they ate the crops of the land of Canaan that year.” —Joshua 5:11-12*

Once the ancient Israelites were a free people in their own land, they could feed themselves from what they grew. This week, like the Israelites, consider where your food comes from. Do you buy produce shipped from thousands of miles away when there are farmer’s markets within a few miles of you? Has it traveled long distances to be processed and packaged? Make a commitment to switch your buying power to more local, in-season foods so as to support the farmers in your region, even if you start small, like giving up bananas shipped from South America if you can get other locally grown fruit now.

## De Monseñor Fran Cilia

---

El capítulo quince del Evangelio de San Lucas está lleno de historias del amor incesante de Dios. Esto es particularmente cierto en la historia del evangelio que escuchamos este domingo. “El hijo pródigo” habla de la riqueza de la misericordia, el perdón y el amor de Dios. De hecho, puede titularse más correctamente como “La parábola del Padre amoroso”.

Algunos de nosotros podemos pensar erróneamente que “pródigo” se refiere al hijo arrepentido cuando decide volver con su padre; sin embargo, “pródigo” en realidad describe la forma en que el joven derrochó la riqueza de su padre.

El hijo mayor solo podía concentrarse en las fechorías de su hermano y no tenía espacio para el perdón en su corazón. Su amargura parece no haberse ido nunca y permanece alejado de su hermano y de su padre, a pesar de las súplicas de su padre: “Hijo mío, siempre estás aquí conmigo; todo lo que tengo es tuyo. Pero ahora debemos celebrar y regocijarnos, porque tu hermano estaba muerto y ha vuelto a la vida; estaba perdido y ha sido encontrado.”

En este Cuarto Domingo de Cuaresma, que cada uno de nosotros no solo experimente un amor que sea como el del padre en esta parábola, sino que también extendamos ese amor perdonador unos a otros.

## **Boletim Paroquial Português**

Domingo IV da Quaresma– C

*Reflexão por: João Pereira Arruda*

Reconciliação é, a palavra chave da liturgia deste Domingo. A Páscoa que vamos celebrar, é o memorial duma libertação do que a dos Hebreus. Preparemo-la pelo Sacramento Pascal da Penitência, o Sacramento da nossa reconciliação com Deus. Assim o entendemos do conteúdo que nos traz a Primeira Leitura tirada do Livro de Josué.

Assim também o entendeu o Povo do Senhor, quen depois de peregrinar por quarenta anos pelo deserto celebrou a Páscoa ao chegar á terra prometida por Deus. A complementar a história da celebração da Páscoa ; São Paulo nos diz, pela sua carta aos cristãos de Corinto para deixar-mos o que foi passado e nos concentrar-mos em “revestirmos do homem novo em Jesus Cristo” Foi Cristo que nos reconciliou com o Pai que nos ama. Foi Cristo que por essa reconciliação nos demonstrou a Sua obediência total ao Pai incluindo a Sua paixão e morte de Crus. Assim ainda acrescenta S. Paulo: “ *A Cristo que não conhecera o pecado, Deus indentificou-O com o pecado por causa de nós, para que em Cristo nos tornemos justiça de Deus.* ” A ilustrar a reconciliação. S. Lucas nos dá a imagem do amor do Pai no abraço de perdão ao filho pródigo. Jesus Cristo dá-nos uma imagem tão transparente do amor misericordioso do Pai. Tal como o filho se arrependeu das grandes transgressões no desbandar da vida e dos haveres, assim o Pai ao vislumbrar o filho ao longe correu para ele para lhe dar o abraço do acolhimento amoroso e o reintegrar na família fazendo-lhe uma festa. Dá-nos também a imagem da continuidade do pecado: tal como a atitude do filho mais velho, que não quiz compreender a misericórdia do amor do Pai. Que tomou uma atitude invejosa em o Pai fazer uma festa na reconciliação do encontro com o filho que andara perdido e desejava voltar a casa para se reconciliar com o Pai: “ *Pai pequei contra o Céu e contra ti, já não mereço ser chamado teu filho.* ” O abraço da reconciliação aconteceu depois e tal qual o nosso Pai do Céu, assim também deveriam ser os pais de agora. O filho mais velho não quiz entender que estando com o Pai tudo que é do Pai também o é dele. A falta de entendimento levou-o ao ressentimento a resposta do Pai nos dá uma imagem muito transparente da lógica da reconciliação e do amor de Deus: “ *Filho tu estás sempre comigo e tudo que é meu é teu. Mas tínhamos de fazer uma festa e alegrar-nos porque este teu irmão estava morto e voltou á vida, estava perdido e foi reencontrado* ” Reparem que quando o filho mais velho se queixou ao pai pelo acolhimento do filho perdido ele disse ao pai “ Este teu filho” O Pai em resposta lhe disse; “Este teu irmão. Pai e filho em polos diferentes. O amor do Pai é constante e igual para todos os seus filhos.; para os que o nunca o abandonam e para os que se perdem e se querem voltar e se reconciliar com Ele.

## **Tempo Quaresmal**

Estamos em pleno Tempo Quaresmal; por assim ser, sugerem-se práticas religiosas apropriadas para esse tempo tais como : penitência, sacrifício, caridade e uma oração mais intensificada. Os livros dispostos no vestíbulo da igreja (inglês e espanhol) e que são grátis dão uma ajuda valiosa para os que querem e desejam meditar de como nos devemos preparar para a Festa das Festas = a Páscoa. O programa tigela de arroz faz-nos participar caritativamente na ajuda aos mais necessitados, para isso os cartões que servem de tigela estão disponíveis no vestíbulo da nossa igreja. A data para o serviço geral penitencial da paróquia Está planeada para o Sábado dia 9 de Abril ás 3 horas da tarde. As devoções da Via-Sacra, serão anunciadas cedo se saiba do programa. E do local em que as mesmas serão feitas. A Romaria Quaresmal de visitas ás igrejas de Santa Clara será levada a efeito no Sábado dia 9 de Abril próximo.
