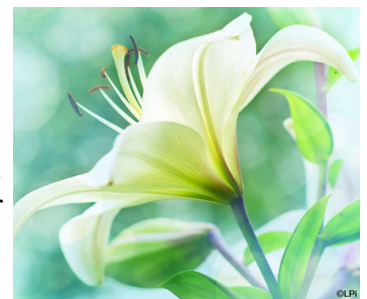
Iniciación de Niños

Lunes, 18 de abril

No teman

Martes, 19 de abril

Es fácil pasar por alto muchas formas en las que Jesús trata de interactuar con nosotros. Él siempre está ahí, esperando a que nuestros ojos se abran y nuestro corazón lo reconozca. Dedique tiempo a conversar con Jesús sobre aquello que necesita ser sanado; haga silencio para escucharlo pronunciar su nombre. *Lecturas de hoy: Hechos 2:36–41; Salmo 33:4–5, 18–19, 20 y 22; Juan 20:11–18.*

Miércoles, 20 de abril

Presencia transformante

Recuerde un momento en el que estuvo más decepcionado por un cambio en su vida. Ese mismo sentimiento habría llevado a los discípulos en el camino a Emaús. Pensando que el hombre al que habían seguido se había ido, volvían a sus vidas anteriores. Luego que Jesús abrió las Escrituras y partió el pan, lo reconocieron y regresaron a Jerusalén. Cada vez que celebramos la Liturgia de la Palabra y la Eucaristía, también experimentamos la apertura de nuestra mente y corazón para ver a Jesús presente con nosotros. ¿Cómo cobrará hoy usted conciencia de la presencia de Jesús en su vida? *Lecturas de hoy: Hechos 3:1–10; Salmo 105:1–2, 3–4, 6–7, 8–9; Lucas 24:13–35.*

Jueves, 21 de abril

Paz

La paz no es ausencia de lucha, miedo ni preocupación. La paz es el don que nos capacita para vivir esas cosas; nos hace conscientes de que no estamos solos. “¿Por qué están preocupados?”, Jesús pregunta a sus discípulos y a nosotros. Cuando las dificultades de la vida parecen abrumadoras, deténgase. Esa pausa nos dará un respiro para acogernos a la presencia de Dios y su promesa de que está con nosotros siempre y en todas las formas. La paz llega haciendo la pausa. *Lecturas de hoy: Hechos 3:11–26; Salmo 8:2ab y 5, 6–7, 8–9; Lucas 24:35–48.*

Viernes, 22 de abril

Piedra angular

Una piedra angular es la que forma la base de una esquina que une dos paredes de un edificio. En Hechos, Pedro llama a Jesús “la piedra angular”. Él es nuestro fundamento y da forma a todo lo que hacemos. Al lidiar con las preocupaciones de su vida, recuerde quién es el que reúne todas las cosas y quién hará el trabajo pesado, aliviando así el estrés y temor: Jesús. *Lecturas de hoy: Hechos 4:1–12; Salmo 118:1–2 y 4, 22–24, 25–27a; Juan 21:1–14.*

Sábado, 23 de abril

Dios está en los detalles

“Es imposible para nosotros no hablar de lo que hemos visto y oído”, dijeron Pedro y Juan a los líderes, que les exigían no hablar ni enseñar en el nombre de Jesús. ¿Cuándo habla usted en el nombre de Jesús?
