



Eucharistic Renewal

Saint Clare Parish will participate in the national program, “Eucharistic Revival,” to encourage us and all Catholics to deepen our understanding and appreciation of the Eucharist, beginning next Sunday, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (*Corpus Christi*).

As Bishop Cantú announced in December 2021, the Diocese of San José seeks spiritual renewal of our local church at all levels. The Eucharistic Revival is the heart of this renewal, which also includes the 2023 Diocesan Synod to discern the direction of the mission and ministry of the local church in Santa Clara County. Over the next three years, every Catholic parish, school, apostolate, and family are invited to be a part of renewing the Church by enkindling a living relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ in the Eucharist and going out in mission “for the life of the world.”

Prv 8:22-31 | Rom 5:1-5 | Jn 16:12-15

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

St. Paul gives us four words to live by: “Hope does not disappoint.” Today, as we celebrate the solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, we are reminded of the source of our hope: God the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, described by Pope Francis as “a communion of love.” As St. Paul writes, “the love of God has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us.” This doesn’t mean our lives won’t be without difficulties, but St. Paul is assuring us that we do not face them alone. As Jesus tells the disciples in today’s Gospel, “when he comes, the Spirit of truth, he will guide you to all truth.” As we move into our week and whatever the near future holds, we can rest assured the Holy Spirit will guide us and strengthen us.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

It’s graduation season! When my oldest son received his college diploma last weekend, I felt overwhelmed with gratitude and excitement for what lies ahead for him. As is the case for many students, his path to a degree was not straight (nor was it paved with straight A’s). Yet here he was, receiving his degree and planning to start a job in a field he loves just two days later. The worries I felt during his high school and early college days dissipated, replaced with a sense of gratitude – and hope. This experience and others like it remind me to bring my worries and concerns to prayer, knowing that Jesus walks beside me and those I love. We can witness to our faith by offering to pray for others facing uncertainties and challenges, and by sharing how we have experienced “peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.”

Domingo da Solenidade da Santíssima Trindade

“ Em nome do Pai, em nome do Filho e em nome do Espírito Santo ”.

É com estas palavras que o sacerdote dá início ao Santo Sacrifício da Missa. Ao pronunciar cada palavra todos se benzem movendo a mão direita da testa para o peito e completando uma cruz movendo depois a mão do ombro esquerdo para o direito. Fazendo este sinal (chamado) da cruz todos nós nos indentificamos como cristãos. Na cruz as três pessoas da Santíssima Trindade, estão presentes no: amor misericordioso do Pai, na doação do Filho em cada um de nós na Santa Eucaristia, na inspiração, apoio espiritual e defensor das nossas almas no Espírito Santo; e é deste modo que nos indentificamos com um Deus Único em Três pessoas distintas. Ao celebrar-mos esta solenidade dedicada á Santíssima Trindade, a igreja litúrgicamente colocou esta celebração a seguir ao Pentecostes, pois o Espírito Santo, várias vezes havia sido prometido por Jesus aos seus Apóstolos e nesta celebração este Mesmo Espírito é o anelo amoroso que liga e completa o amor entre o Pai e o Filho. Este amor infinito e indistóvel por vezes é comparado ao amor do casal entre os esposos e destes pelos filhos; pois que' pelo sacramento do matrimónio o casal é auxiliado pelo relacionamento de Jesus Cristo no laço amoroso um pelo outro e no apoio de vida e de dons do casal para os filhos. Deste amor que une a família nuclear cristã está presente o nosso Deus na Santíssima Trindade. O Mistério da Santíssima Trindade continua a ser isso mesmo: um MISTÉRIO; Não nos compete desvendar ou perceber a lógica de Deus. Somos meramente mortais e sendo assim que nos concentremos nas coisas que estão ao alcance dos mortais de compreenderem, actuarem e fazerem. Ao longo da bíblia vemos aqui e ali passagens que estão fora do alcance humano de perceber ou da ciencia desvendar, por assim ser não desperdicemos tempo a dar lógica ou sugestões a Deus , mas ousamos ter fé e corresponder ao Seu Amor.

Esta festa que se faz nesta cidade de Santa Clara desde 1896; depois do forte da pandemia, volta a ser celebrada num esforço de se voltar á normalização desta celebração anual. Este ano Manuel Silveira e a Mesa Directiva fizeram este planeamento de acordo com o que é possível nestes tempos pandemicos. Cabe a cada um de nós apoiar esse esforço, cos as nossas esmolas com as nossas presenças, é deste modo que se dá continuidade a esta tradição centenária que engloba a nossa cultura social e religiosa. A idade avançada é uma desculpa de não intervir e participar nestas celebrações e a passividade é um pecado que mina e destroi aquilo que os nossos antepassados amassaram e criaram com muito sacrifício e suor, está em cada um de nós avivar e contribuir adentro do que se pode financeiramente e de doar-nos pelo voluntariado com os dons gratuitos doados pelo Espírito Santo e que os mesmos devem ser doados e investidos no bem comum de toda a nossa comunidade. Elevemos as nossas orações em agradecimento pelo esforço que a SES fez para celebrar a Festa ao Espírito Santo e elevemos as nosas orações ao Espírito Santo para motivar os nosos jovens em aderirem e liderarem no gerir e promover essas nossas festas e tradições trazidas pelos primeiros imigrantes que se estabeleceram no então Vale de Santa Clara. Da parte do CPP vai um enorme agradecimento e assim pedimos ao Espírito Santo que aos responsaveis desta Festa sejam abençoados com a Sua graça; Bem hajam!


