

Over the next three years, every Catholic parish, school, apostolate, and family are invited to be a part of renewing the Church by enkindling a living relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ in the Eucharist and going out in mission “for the life of the world.”

Creation Care Tips

“The cup of blessing which we bless, is it not a sharing of the blood of Christ? The bread which we break, is it not a sharing in the body of Christ?” —1 Corinthians 10:16

Each time we commemorate the Last Supper, we invite Jesus to be part of our lives. In doing so, the community becomes his body. For that reason, it would be wise to take a moment and consider our choice of bread. Much bread in the United States today is produced by industrial agricultural practices that use pesticides and cause irreparable damage to ecosystems. Intensive agriculture also uses chemical fertilizers which the rain washes into our rivers, causing blue algae in our lakes. Since Christ is at the very center of creation, let us choose an organic bread to honor the Body of Christ. Often times farmer's markets and small bakeries carry bread that is more responsibly produced. Consider switching your bread buying power to such vendors.

Diocesan Year of Prayer

A message from Bishop Oscar Cantú:

Not only will we participate in the universal synod in a few months, but in preparation for our 50th anniversary, I invite us all – laity, religious, and clergy – to participate in our first Diocesan Synod, which will begin in Advent 2022. In this Diocesan Synod, I will invite us to reflect on the question, “where does our local Church of San José need to be in 10 years to live and proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ effectively in Silicon Valley into the future? Moreover, to be faithful to the mission of Jesus Christ, what do we need to do differently? What strengths can we leverage? What obstacles must we overcome? Do we need to pivot from old ministries to new ones? These are all broad questions, and I’m sure, with thoughtful prayer, there will be various and creative ideas to offer. We will surface those ideas and then enter a process of discerning the voice of the Holy Spirit amid the many voices.

To begin to prepare ourselves and our Diocese for our 50th Jubilee, I invite us all – laity, religious, and clergy – to participate in a **Year of Prayer** to convoke the **Holy Spirit** in our discernment process. The Holy Spirit inspires, strengthens, and guides the Church, and we need to listen prayerfully to the Spirit’s promptings so that our Diocese might embark on a journey of faith that is “ever ancient, ever new.” Pope Francis reminds us that God is God of surprises. It is in the spirit of prayer that we can prepare our hearts and our “spiritual ears” to hear his voice and to respond with courage, wonder, faith, and zeal.



Dia do Pai

“Quem come a minha Carne e bebe o meu Sangue permanece em Mim e Eu nele”. Assim diz o Senhor e nesta frase está a base desta

Solenidade que vem depois da vinda do Espírito Santo e antes do Tempo Comum. Com esta Solenidade a Igreja de coração inundado ainda pelas alegrias pascais e no fervor do Espírito Santo, dá largas ao entusiasmo para celebrar numa atmosfera de louvor e de exultação espiritual, o Mistério da presença amorosa e operante de Jesus Cristo no meio dos homens. Inserida na liturgia de hoje e cumprindo uma tradição social religiosa a Igreja celebra o Pai. É assim que no terceiro Domingo do mês de Junho celebramos nas missas deste Domingo; o Pai. Figura esta que noutras tempos, noutras eras era a figura principal da família. Hoje porém está muito diminuída e amaranhada. Tal como o Dia da Mãe, o Dia do Pai está ligada ao comércio oportunista, porém na igreja se faz esforços para que a figura do Pai seja dignificada com todo o respeito que este merece. Em Igreja celebramos o Pai que adentro do que lhe devido de amar a mulher e os filhos faz tudo o que pode para providenciar meios de subsistência, providenciar segurança à família mesmo tomando riscos de vida em prol de proteger a vida dos demais membros da família. A Igreja traz-nos duas figuras muito relevantes que se ligam à vida quotidiana dos pais deste mundo e desta vida. O nosso Pai do Céu e nosso Deus é o Criador, o Misericordioso, é aquele que revemos na figura do Pai na parábola do filho pródigo. Por este mundo os pais também procuram adentro das suas limitações aproximar-se mais dos filhos que caiem em “desventuras”, mesma que estes gestos de amor e ajuda façam criar ciúmes nos outros filhos eles fazem esforços para levantar e recuperar os filhos que caem em desgraças. S. José é a outra figura mítica do pai. Fez-se pai adoptivo de Jesus Cristo por ter desposado Maria, Mãe de Jesus. Ao tomar Maria por esposa assumiu todos os riscos de a proteger e a Jesus de Herodes que O queria matar. Com o seu trabalho de carpinteiro serviu de meio de subsistência para toda a família. Ao desposar Maria S. José ao mesmo tempo protegeu-a do opróbrio e vergonha porque ao fim e ao cabo Maria iria ter um filho que não o era seu. É assim ainda hoje os pais que formam por esposas mulheres que já têm filhos e os assumem como pai adentro deste processo formam uma família nuclear cristã. Sendo o cabeça de uma família nuclear cristã são obreiros da base de uma sociedade só são evangelizadores pelo exemplo de vida. Este é o pai que celebramos em igreja, este tipo de pai é abençoado pelo Espírito Santo de amor misericordioso do Pai do Céu. Por assim ser, a Igreja celebra o Pai neste dia, porque tal como a mãe é peça fundamental numa família. Que não nos esqueçamos de que o Pai do Céu para completar a Sua obra de salvação com o mistério da Encarnação empossou S.
