We might wonder what was behind the question put to Jesus, “Lord, will only a few people be saved?”. Was the questioner hoping that the number who would be saved would be very small? Or, perhaps, the person was looking for another answer, namely, that salvation was offered to many.

Interestingly, Jesus’ answer is both. While many of those who were called will not be able to enter God’s kingdom, even more people—from the farthest reaches of the earth – will find welcome there. For Jesus, it was not a matter of religion or geography, but of one’s willingness to “enter through the narrow gate,” to welcome Jesus’ way and live it.

Even though He uses this imagery, the circle Jesus draws includes all kinds of people, rather than trying to exclude anyone. This inclusivity extends to us and is a challenge for us also to draw the circles of our lives broadly, allowing as many people in as possible. I say that it is a challenge, because many of us are comfortable only with those whom we consider to be like ourselves.

Our richly diverse parish family is rich because of its diversity. And still we rejoice in our unity in the Lord. May the tapestry of our lives be the same.

Don’t forget this Sunday’s Movie Night. Details can be found in the flier printed in this Bulletin. We hope to see many of you at this annual event.

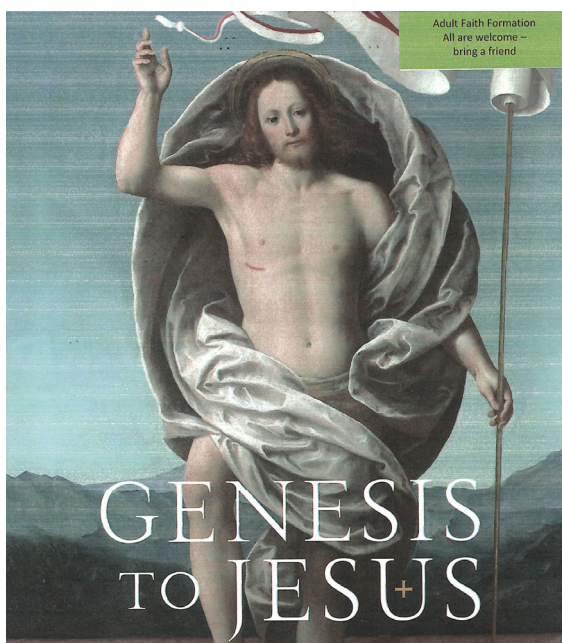


Opportunities for Faith Formation/Catechetics

As summer winds down and schools reopen, it is also time for us to renew our parish efforts of “religious education,” otherwise known as Faith Formation. When parents presented their children for Baptism, one of the promises they made was to “keep the flame of faith burning brightly” in their lives. Baptism is the door that opens to the whole of life in Christ. But in order to walk down that path, young people in particular need to come to know Jesus more and more.

Formal education in faith is as important as academics. Just as we cannot neglect education in all of the subjects at school, so we cannot skip religious education. Registration is now open for grades 1 through 6, as well as for Middle School and High School, including preparation for the sacraments of Eucharist, Confirmation and Reconciliation. For adults, we also offer “RCIA,” primarily for non-Catholics who wish to learn more about the Church and possibly become members of it through Baptism or, for other Christians, a Profession of Faith and the celebration of Confirmation. Adult Catholics who have not received the Eucharist or celebrated Confirmation can prepare for those sacraments. Sessions begin in September.

WE ARE BACK IN SESSION!

On Wednesday, August 17, our students returned back to school. We are so grateful for the joyful noise which fills our hallways once again! We welcomed new families, students, and teachers to our vibrant community.

If you live in the neighborhood, or if you are around the Saint Clare campus during drop off and pick-up time, we appreciate your patience and kindness. Drop off begins at 7:45 each morning and pick-up concludes by 3:15 in the afternoon, except on Wednesdays (12:45 P.M.). We thank you for helping keep our students, families, and staff safe. Our students and teachers cross the street throughout the school day to attend classes in the middle school building and the Hall.

On Friday, August 19, our teachers were commissioned as catechists during our Opening School Mass. As Catholic school educators, it is our mission to partner with parents in the formation of their child's faith. We walk the journey together to help students grow in their love of God and one another.

Join us for weekly masses at 10:45 A.M. in the Outdoor Church (tent). This year's theme is "A GRATEFUL HEART". What better way to practice this habit by joining us in Thanksgiving each week. We are happy to worship with you!

NEW THIS YEAR: On-Site Occupational Therapy for TK-5th graders and other identified learners

Saint Clare School is proud to welcome Mrs. Erica Davied and On Track Therapy. Mrs. Davied will be working with the TK-5th grade classes, offering in-classroom therapy one hour per week, per grade, addressing handwriting, gross and fine motor skills development, visual/perceptual motor and sensory development. These skills are critical to the learning process.

The TKers and Kindergarteners will use the newly installed OT clinic in the middle school building to participate in small group sensory and motor experiences, all while working on their acquisition of foundational skills necessary to support their academic development.

In addition to in-classroom and clinic services, individual OT sessions will be provided to children whose needs are not readily met in a classroom setting. We are excited to add this program which seeks to make learning accessible for all.

CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT: The work of accreditation Self-Study

Our faculty and staff continue to dialog regarding the accreditation factors as part of our WCEA/ACS WASC Self Study. Last year, we revised our Mission Statement and developed Schoolwide Learning Expectations (SLEs). This year, we have begun creating rubrics to assess the SLEs and are looking at data to inform our conversations around accreditation factors. We will keep you posted on our progress. Stay tuned!

Permitting process is under way for middle school HVAC upgrades. We have received proposals for our elementary upgrades and will start the process shortly. Podríamos preguntarnos qué había detrás de la pregunta que se le hizo a Jesús: “Señor, ¿se salvarán unos pocos?”. ¿Esperaba el interrogador que el número de los que se salvarían fuera muy pequeño? O, tal vez, la persona estaba buscando otra respuesta, a saber, que la salvación era ofrecida a muchos.

Curiosamente, la respuesta de Jesús es ambas cosas. Si bien muchos de los que fueron llamados no podrán entrar en el reino de Dios, aún más personas, desde los confines de la tierra, serán bienvenidos allí. Para Jesús, no era una cuestión de religión o geografía, sino de la propia voluntad de “entrar por la puerta estrecha”, de acoger el camino de Jesús y vivirlo.

Aunque usa esta imagen, el círculo que dibuja Jesús incluye todo tipo de personas, en lugar de tratar de excluir a alguien. Esta inclusión se extiende a nosotros y es un desafío para nosotros también dibujar los círculos de nuestras vidas de manera amplia, permitiendo la entrada de tantas personas como sea posible. Digo que es un desafío, porque muchos de nosotros nos sentimos cómodos solo con aquellos a quienes consideramos como nosotros mismos.

Nuestra familia parroquial ricamente diversa es rica debido a su diversidad. Y todavía nos regocijamos en nuestra unidad en el Señor. Que el tapiz de nuestras vidas sea el mismo.

Oportunidades para la Formación en la Fe/Catequesis

A medida que el verano termina y las escuelas vuelven a abrir, también es hora de que renovemos nuestros esfuerzos parroquiales de "educación religiosa", también conocida como Formación en la Fe. Cuando los padres presentaban a sus hijos para el bautismo, una de las promesas que hacían era “mantener la llama de la fe ardiendo intensamente” en sus vidas. A liturgia de hoje fala-se em portas estreitas! O Reino de Deus não tem lugar os protocolos e convenções das sociedades terrenas. Privilégios e velhas tradições não contam. Empenhe-se cada um em viver a Boa Nova e terá assegurada a salvação. Uma das tarefas mais difíceis dos pais, dos patrões, dos professores e até dos departamentos de justiça é disciplinar : os filhos, os empregados, os alunos e todos aqueles que cometeram injustiças ou erros de qualquer espécie tem que estar sujeito a receber as consequências e enquanto tem pelo Seu amor uma lógica de justiça distinta da justiça humana não deixa de aplicar destinos diferentes aqueles que praticaram o bem, que fizeram esforços de amar e de se entregarem em doar os seus bens e talentos em função do bem comum da família, da paróquia, da comunidade, da sociedade; destes Jesus fala-nos do Reino de Deus como prémio de todos esses que aderiram e viveram segundo a Sua Palavra. Do outro lado terá outro destino aqueles que fizeram das suas vidas projectos de destruir as vidas das pessoas pelas vias da: ganância, poder, violência, corrupção, crimes de toda a espécie que fizeram do mundo em que viveram em desunião, empobrecido, que negaram a existência de Deus fazendo de si mesmo deuses de poder e de dinheiro.
