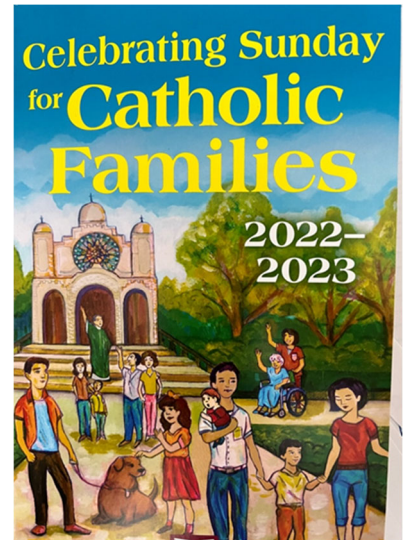

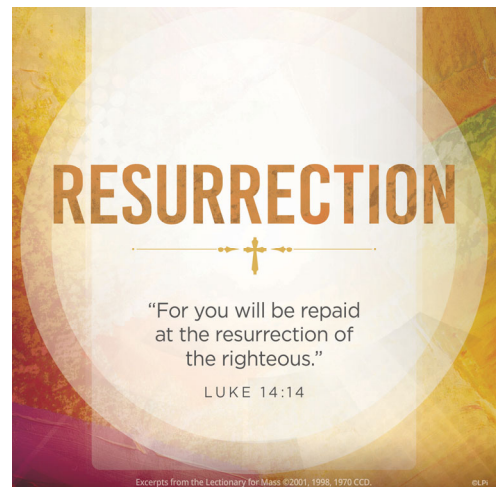

## De Monseñor Fran Cilia

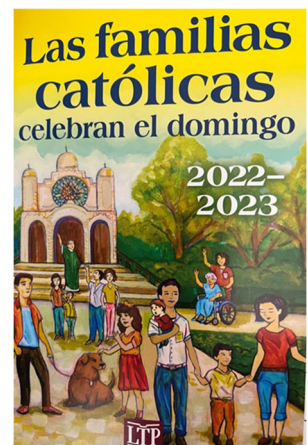

A caminhada para todo aquele que quer seguir a Cristo, tem que se deixar moldar por Cristo. Por esse processo tem que saber as consequências que implica seguir a Cristo e o de ser “cristão” Tem que perceber que o crescimento implica o “acumular”, o crescer está no acúmulo de riquezas e se estas são materiais para proteger essas riquezas implica fazer muros, paredes de proteção e o resultado é: que para proteger as riquezas perde a liberdade de ser o que seja e torna-se prisioneiro do dinheiro – riqueza. Se procura acumular dons espirituais, de virtudes e de cultivar o coração a amar e servir os outros; só “e verdadeiramente discípulo se todos esses dons e graças que recebe de Deus só dá fruto, só são efectivos quando os mesmos são doados em função de colmatar as carências que passam os necessitados que nos rodeiam. Foram essas as indicações que Jesus Cristo nos tem dado nestes últimos evangelhos. O que aconteceu ao agricultor rico que acumulou tanto trigo ao ponto de não caber nos celeiros? Em vez de dar aos necessitados mandou fazer mais celeiros e o resultado dessa sua decisão resultou na sua própria morte. Já os antigos diziam que o futuro a Deus pertence e foi neste caso o resultado de ser “prisioneiro” dos bens acumulados para servirem o seu egoísmo. Santa Teresa de Calcutá dizia: “ tudo o que não se dá, perde-se” . O discípulo de Cristo tem que ser moldado pelo amor. Não há nada mais triste do que ver cristãos que perderam o coração ou que o desperdiçaram porque o entregaram ao maligno pelos males do ciúme, da inveja ou ressentimento. Quem não sabe dar graças a Deus na alegria, não sabe partilhar a vida com Deus, não O saberá reconhecer nos dias de infortúnio e desolação e viverá abandonado rodeado de desertos e abismos. Os métodos do “acumulação” não são maus desde que o que seja que decidimos acumular sirva para um processo de amar a Deus no servir o outro, o irmão, aquele que carece do que tens a mais. Reparem que os bens espirituais que se possuem, estes também, não são nossos e devem ser partilhados através do voluntariado ao serviço da família, da paróquia, da comunidade. Decidir ficar de braços cruzados quando se opta para não os dar ou usar, esses dons ficam perdidos e no processo, perde-se algo doado por Deus que não atingiu o seu objectivo de: ser usado para o bem comum de todos. Cada um de nós é amado e querido por Deus e foi criado para amar. Isso basta! Tudo o resto deve ser tido, a exemplo de São Paulo tido como lixo.

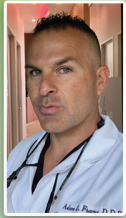
### **Piquenique Anual da nossa Comunidade**

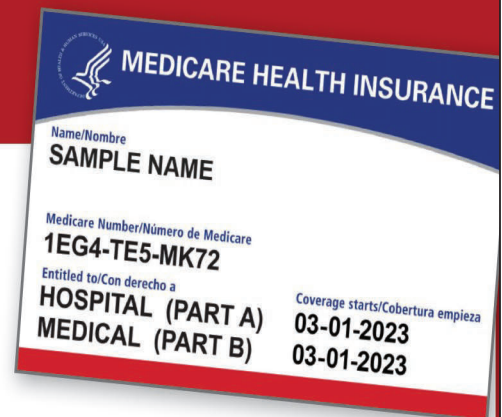

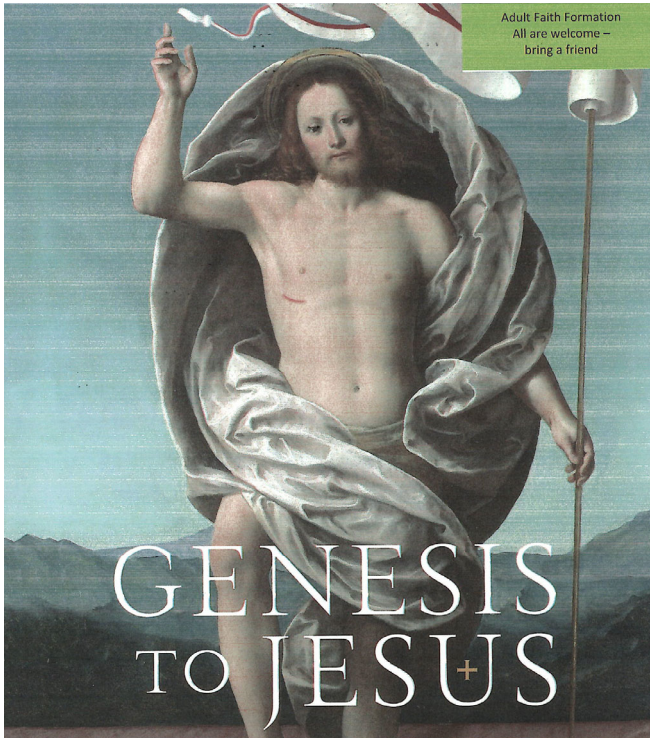
