

Boletim Paroquial Português
18 de Junho de 2023; Domingo XI do Tempo Comum – A
Reflexão pelo Padre Francisco Rodrigues SJ

A Seara é grande mas os trabalhadores são poucos!

O evangelho deste domingo recorda-nos alguns temas tão queridos na nossa vida cristã, desde logo, o modo como Jesus é apresentado: o Senhor enche-se de compaixão. Só se enche de compaixão quem tem coração! Deus, em Jesus, apresenta-se como Aquele que tem um coração compassivo. De seguida, Jesus olha para o povo que o procura e compadece-se: são como ovelhas sem pastor. Nós sabemos que os pastores são essenciais na condução e confirmação de uma comunidade. Um corpo não vive sem a cabeça. Uma comunidade dispersa-se e perde a referência se não é acompanhada pelo pastor. Por isso, Jesus escolheu um grupo de pastores que colocou à frente da Igreja para a servir e orientar na fé. Apascenta as minhas ovelhas diz Jesus a Pedro (cf. João, 21, 17). A Igreja não precisa de pastores preocupados em fazerem a vontade das pessoas mas sim, em fazerem a vontade de Deus. Só a vontade que vem de Deus nos deve alimentar e só esta devemos desejar. A vontade de Deus não ilude, não engana, não nos deixa vazios. Por isso, a Igreja precisa de bons e santos pastores. Jesus recorda-nos que a seara é grande e os trabalhadores são poucos. Este desabafo de Jesus é de um enorme significado: como é possível que não haja trabalhadores suficientes para construirmos o Reino de Deus? A empresa de Jesus oferece-nos o pão para o dia-a-dia e para a vida eterna. A empresa de Jesus oferece-nos felicidade, saúde verdadeira com rasgos de vida eterna. Na empresa de Jesus, andamos sempre à procura de trabalhadores! A seara é grande. São poucos os trabalhadores. Porquê? Deveríamos responder a esta pergunta com a nossa oração.

Oxalá o evangelho deste domingo nos toque e humanize em três aspetos. Primeiro, aprendermos com Jesus a sermos compassivos, bons e acolhedores. Segundo, rezarmos para que haja bons e santos pastores na vinha do Senhor. Terceiro: arregaçarmos as mangas e trabalharmos na seara que é a Igreja e assim, com os nossos talentos, tempo e tesouros, a Igreja possa viver e cumprir melhor o seu mandado de evangelização ao serviço das comunidades cristãs. Na Igreja pode não haver emprego, mas trabalho nunca faltará a quem quiser trabalhar e quando mais quisermos trabalhar por amor a Deus e à Igreja mais comunidade e Igreja construiremos.
