

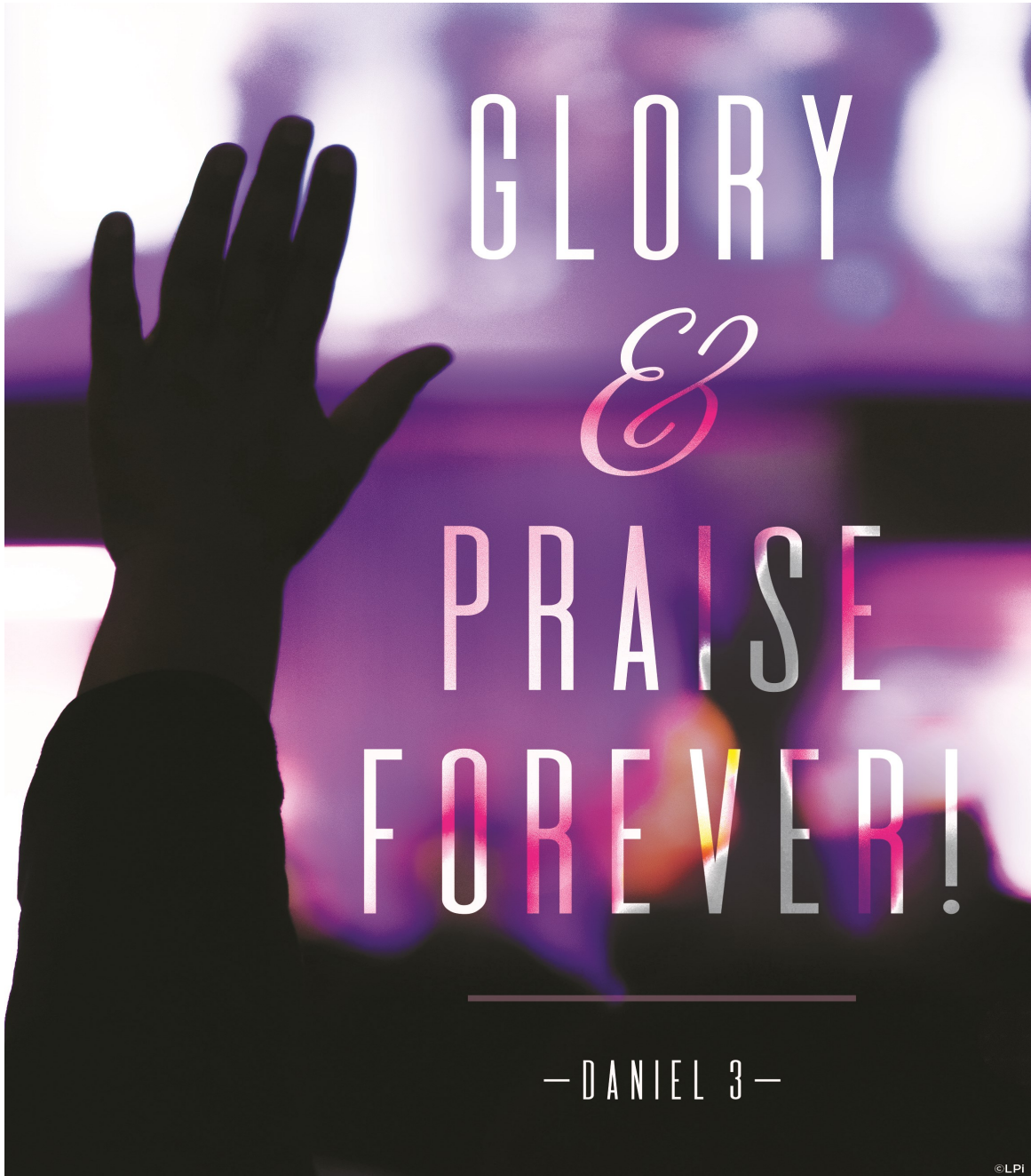

Saint John's most precise description of God is: "God is love." This does not mean simply that God is loving, but that it is God's nature, before all else, the essence of God is love poured out. Love is the bond among the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. It is the source of all that is, all that has been and will ever be throughout the entirety of the universe or even the sum of all possible universes. To be anything other than love cannot be. God's love is not a selfish love, as though God were looking into the mirror and is pleased.

Saint Augustine describes it this way: God is the Lover, the Beloved *and* the Love that is between Lover and Beloved. The Father loves the Son, and the Son the Father and the bond of their love is the Spirit, which is poured into our hearts. That love is so great that Creation was the result – It is another great mystery, how something came into being from nothingness.

This is what we celebrate this weekend as the foundation of all and, at the very same time, as the goal of our lives: to be love as God is love.

Weekly Justice Challenge

Today we celebrate a mystery - the mystery that is the Most Holy Trinity, three Persons yet one God. The Trinity exists in perfect communion and community as Father, Son and Spirit. God doesn't just give perfect love - God is Love, and that love reveals itself in the relationship of Father, Son and Spirit. Your challenge this week is to make the connection between love and justice. As Pope Benedict wrote in *Caritas in Veritate*, "Love - caritas - is an extraordinary force which leads people to opt for courageous and generous engagement in the field of justice and peace. It is a force that has its origin in God, Eternal Love and Absolute Truth." Reflect this week on the following questions (as individuals and as families): "How does God's love for us compel us to take action to fight injustice? Who needs our love the most this week - in the family, in our community, and in our world? How can we share our love? Is it through service, advocacy, financial support or something else?" Select one way of living justice through the lens of love - and do it!

HVAC UPDATES

Work continues in the Middle School building to ready the plumbing and electrical connections while we wait for the electrical panels to fire up the units in mid-June.

Exciting news on the Elementary side: work has begun to ready the installation of Mitsubishi units in each of the classrooms and offices. Starting June 12, work equipment, a storage container, and work trucks will be in and out of the elementary school lot to prepare the concrete pads for condensers, install plumbing, and electrical connections, and install units in the classrooms. HVAC in the elementary side is slated to be fired up in November. As such, our summer camp, which serves many families who need child care during summer months, will be housed in the Middle School rooms and lot. Thank you for your patience and for sharing this space with our camp.

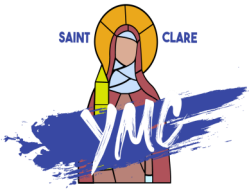

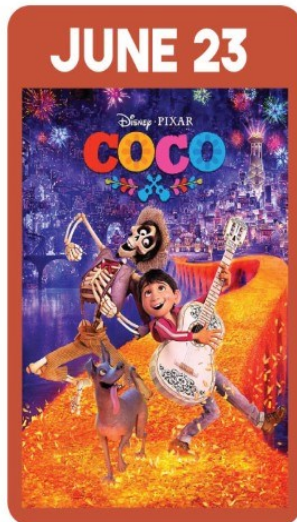




Youth Ministry

Our youth ministry session today, June 4th, is cancelled.

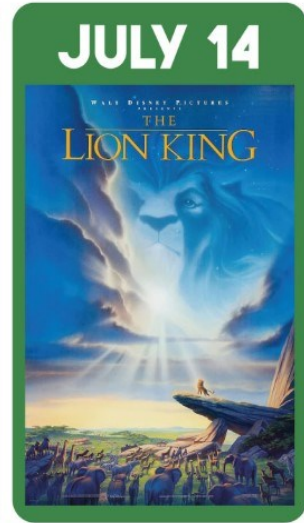
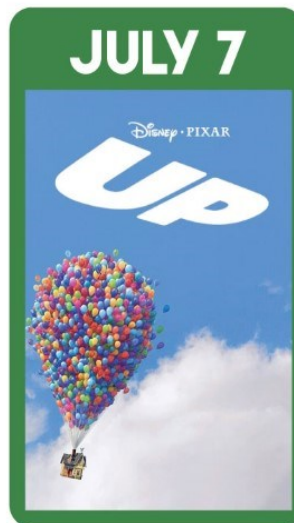
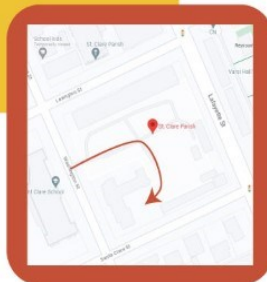

Reflexão pelo padre Francisco Rodrigues SJ



Quem n'Ele acredita não é condenado mas quem n'Ele não acredita já está condenado!

Deus não quer que ninguém se condene. Deus não poderia ter feito por nós mais do que Ele fez e faz. Deus sonha com a nossa felicidade neste mundo e na eternidade que nos espera. No entanto, Ele não nos obriga a amá-lo, nem nos obriga a que nos amemos. Deus, em Jesus, não obriga ninguém a ir para o Céu. Jesus criou umas 'escadinhas' que nos dão acesso ao Céu mas temos que ser nós a subi-las. Jesus inaugurou a porta de entrada no céu, mas temos que tocar à campainha para nela entrar. O amor de Deus é incrível, é criativo e oblativo mas temos que colaborar. Jesus não age sozinho. Nós não somos ilhas, não nos salvamos sozinhos. La descripción más precisa de Dios por parte de San Juan es: “Dios es amor”. Esto no significa simplemente que Dios es amoroso, sino que es la naturaleza de Dios, ante todo, la esencia de Dios es el amor derramado. El amor es el vínculo entre el Padre, el Hijo y el Espíritu Santo. Es la fuente de todo lo que es, todo lo que ha sido y será en la totalidad del universo o incluso la suma de todos los universos posibles. Ser otra cosa que el amor no puede ser. El amor de Dios no es un amor egoísta, como si Dios se mirara en el espejo y estuviera complacido.

San Agustín lo describe así: Dios es el Amante, el Amado y el Amor que hay entre Amante y Amado. El Padre ama al Hijo, y el Hijo al Padre y el vínculo de su amor es el Espíritu, que se derrama en nuestros corazones. Ese amor es tan grande que la Creación fue el resultado. Es otro gran misterio, cómo algo surgió de la nada.

Eso es lo que celebramos este fin de semana como fundamento de todo y, al mismo tiempo, como meta de nuestra vida: ser amor como Dios es amor.

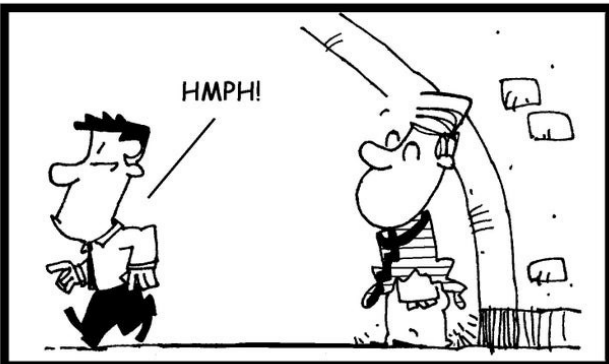

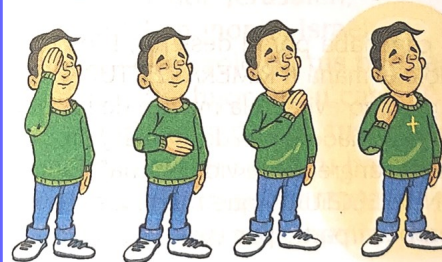
