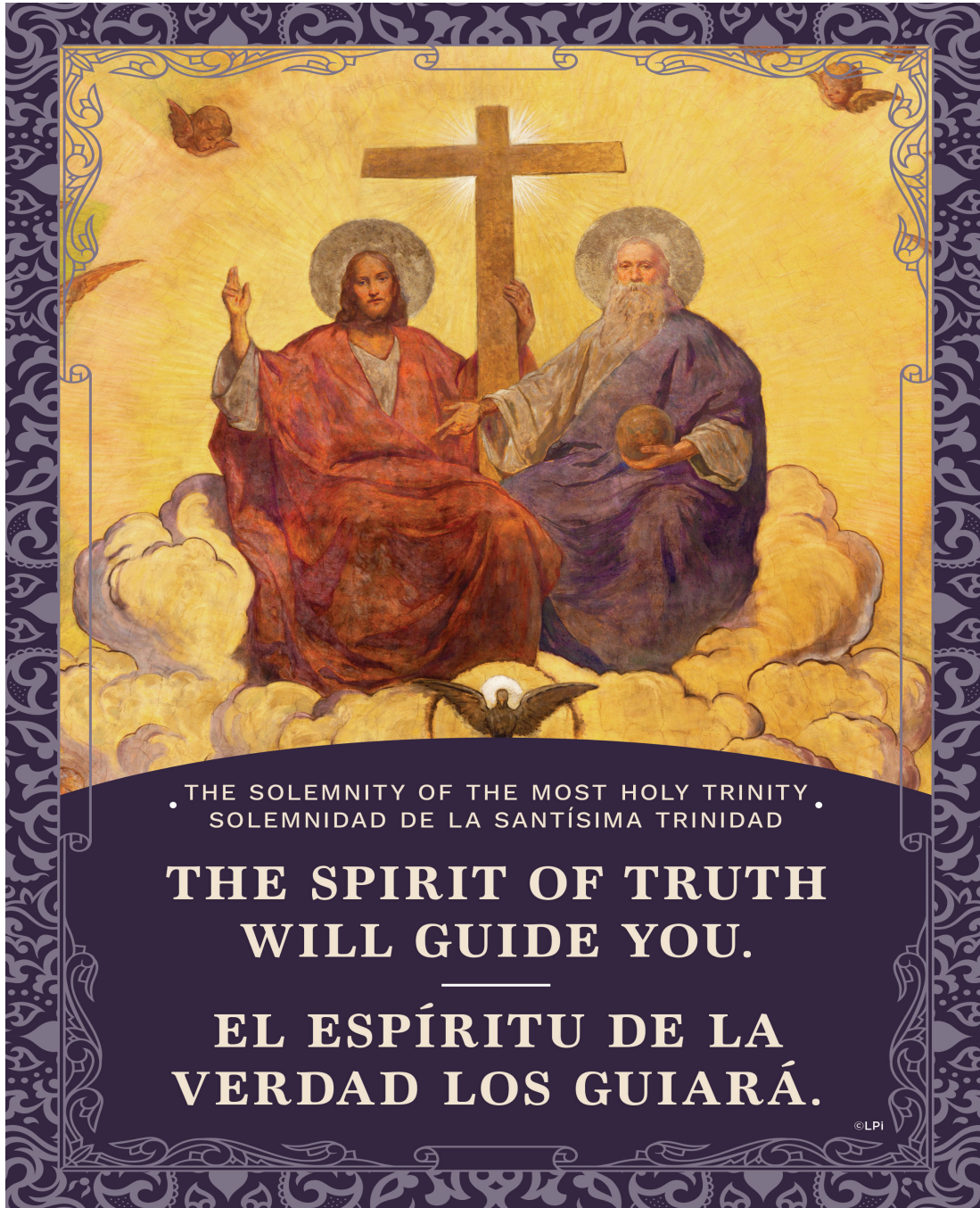

From Monsignor Fran

In keeping with last Sunday's celebration of Pentecost and next weekend's observance of "Corpus Christi," the Body and Blood of the Lord, we focus on mysteries central to our faith: the coming of the Holy Spirit, the Eucharistic Body and Blood of Christ and, this weekend, the Trinity of God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, Whom we proclaim as three Persons, one God, separate, yet equal in all ways.

According to Saint Augustine, "God is the Lover, the Beloved and the Love that is between Lover and Beloved. The Father loves the Son and the bond of their love is the Spirit, which is poured into our hearts."

We proclaim the mystery of the Blessed Trinity as a "communion," or relationship, that models for us the bonds between and among us – spouses, family members, friends, co-workers. None of us exists in a vacuum; we flourish through our interactions with one another, in a communion of love, as is God's.

15 de Junho de 2025; Domingo da Solenidade de da Santíssima Trindade
Reflexão Por: João Pereira Arruda

Chegado ao altar o sacerdote que irá presidir a missa dá início dizendo: “A graça do Senhor Jesus Cristo, o amor de Deus Pai e a comunhão do Espírito Santo; estejam com todos vós” em resposta dizemos; e contigo também. No Domingo em que a Igreja celebra esta solenidade tem esta frase muito mais significado. Fazendo o sinal da Cruz, o cristão anuncia a Santíssima Trindade. Na Cruz de Jesus, lá também está o Pai e o Espírito Santo. Nas nossas terras de origem os sinos repicavam á luz da aurora e os cristãos faziam o sinal da Cruz dizendo “Em nome do Pai, do Filho e do Espírito Santo”. O mesmo acontecia ao meio do dia e residentes e ou todos que escutavam o tocar dos sinos imediatamente paravam descobriam a cabeça dos barretos e repetiam o mesmo sinal da Cruz uma vez mais anunciando “Em nome do Pai e do Filho e do Espírito Santo”. Uma vez mais o teco dos sinos tocavam ao por do Sol e fazendo o sinal da cruz davam graças por mais um dia de vida neste mundo, Era esse toque reconhecido como o toque das trindades proveniente da Santíssima Trindade.. Deste modo o sino era de extrema importância numa sociedade donde haviam poucos relógios de pulso e as populações dependiam dos sinos do campanário da igreja É um dos maiores mistérios como pode ser o nosso Deus um só se Eles são divinos iguais mas distintos? Não podemos entender, mas somos pela fé convidados a acreditar que os mistérios de Deus, não dá para entender-los mas sim pela fé acreditar que assim é. A Santíssima Trindade simboliza um Deus único e verdadeiro, que no amor se completa uns nos outros. A nível humano o que pode ser mais parecido é quando, um homem e uma mulher recebem o sacramento do matrimónio fazendo os votos de amarem-se para o resto das suas vidas com a permanente presença de Cristo no seu relacionamento e nas suas vidas até que sejam separados pela morte.. O casal por assim ser não são duas pessoas mas só estão completos com Jesus Cristo no meio do seu relacionamento e da sua família e no todo resulta numa pequena igreja doméstica.

A Sociedade do Espírito Santo de Santa Clara, apareceu nesta cidade em 1896. Diz o ditado; “donde estiver dois açorianos aí se celebra o Espírito Santo” e assim foi o caso que aconteceu nesse tempo em que a nossa cidade era local de acolhimento albergava três comunidades: a italiana, a portuguesa e a mexicana. Estas três comunidades de novos imigrantes eram sobretudo peritos em trabalhos de agricultura ou lavoura e com o seu trabalho árduo foram crescendo e progredindo no crescimento de Santa Clara. O desejo de celebrarem o Espírito Santo levou os açorianos irem a Half Moon Bay trazer emprestado as insígnias do Espírito Santo e como lá eles celebravam os Espírito Santo no Domingo do Pentecostes resolverem fazer a coroação e festa ao Espírito Santo no Domingo da Santíssima Trindade. A falta de concentração e de entrega aos dons do Espírito Santo levou os portugueses desunirem-se e dessa desunião resultou uma ruptura de um grupo concentrar-se em explorar seguros de vida e outro grupo fazer a festa a que estamos acostumados a celebrar nos nossos dias. A razão central da celebração religiosa que as nossas organizações portuguesas fazem todos os esforços devem centrar-se na preparação religiosa; seja o Espírito Santo, o Senhor Santo Cristo dos Milagres, Nossa Senhora ou qualquer Santo os esforços que se possa angariar devem todos serem investidos no objectivo de louvar, honrar, e dignificar o padroeiro a que se faz a festa. Qunã e se assim acontece é porque houve unidade entre os membros directivos e existiu uma responsável gerência de Doms.

O Conselho Paroquial saúda e congratula neste dia a Mesa Directiva da SES na sua Presidente Filomena Ávila. Que seja o Senhor Espírito Santo a abençoar-la e seus membros directivos de celebrarem neste Domingo e na missa portuguesa esta festa dedicada á terceira pessoa da Santíssima Trindade. Bem hajam.

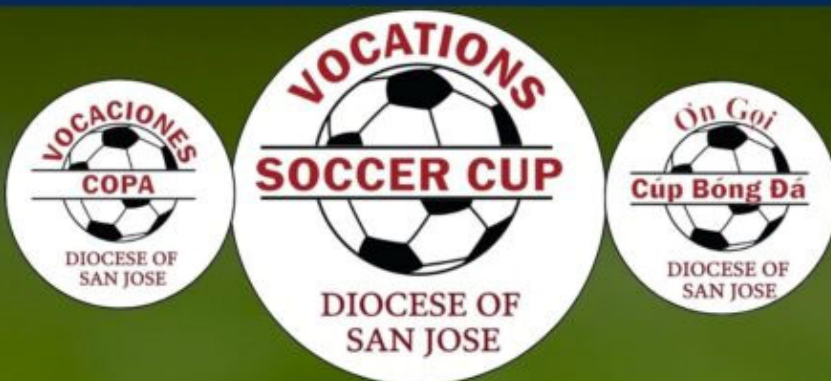
