

From Monsignor Fran

Saints Peter and Paul are held in such esteem by the Church that their feast takes precedence over the primary weekly feast of the Lord's Day, which we celebrate every Sunday.

Their paths were not parallel; Peter followed Jesus from the beginning, was chosen by the Lord to be "the rock on which I will build my church." This is the same man who denied knowing Jesus, as he was questioned, simultaneous with the Lord's trial and condemnation.

Paul, on the other hand, calls himself "one untimely born," because his first encounter with Jesus was on the road to Damascus, where he was traveling to condemn those who believed in the Lord. We remember that when Stephen was stoned to death, Paul (or Saul, as he was then called) was present and approved of Stephen's being stoned to death.

Peter was likely a peasant and Paul a well-educated man and a citizen of Rome.

Only in God's plan could these people of such divergent backgrounds become two of the most prominent leaders of the earliest days of the Church, rightly called, "the Apostolic Church."

As we celebrate our roots, we see in the work of these two and the other apostles the commission that is given to us. . .to be faithful to and to preach God's word by the way we live, so as to continue to build up the Church in our midst, working always toward nurturing the coming of God's Reign.

Weekly/Monthly/Annual Stewardship

“Stewardship” can mean many things to us. Among these is a care for that which has been entrusted to us, as in “stewarding the gift of creation.”

In Spanish, the word for stewardship is “coresponsabilidad.” Co-responsibility gets to the heart of the stewardship that is asked of us. It is shared responsibility for the good of the whole. In the case of our parish, financial responsibility falls to every member. It is not fair to depend up a few to carry the rest of us. Each is responsible, according to their means, to do what they can.

As has been shared in the past weeks, we have fallen short of budget for our weekly income (currently \$10,100 per week). To cover expenses in the year that begins on July 1, we need to raise our weekly goal to \$10,400, the smallest increase we can make and come close to paying our bills.

To reduce expenses, we have lowered our weekly order of doughnuts by six dozen and eliminated the delivery of drinking water to the rectory. We will also continue to look for other ways to trim our budget.

Thank you for bringing to prayer how you, your family or household can support the work of the parish in the coming year.

Boletim Paroquial Português
29 de Junho de 2025, Domingo da Solenidade de São Pedro e São Paulo
Reflexão Por: João Pereira Arruda

Jesus depois de ter experimentado Pedro, perguntando-lhe por três vezes se O amava e por cada resposta Pedro afirmou-Lhe que sim; que O amava, Jesus ordenou São Pedro: “Segue-Me!” São Pedro, nada mais disse, mas simplesmente limitou-se a seguir Jesus. Não houve perguntas da parte de São Pedro.: para onde me levas, que vamos fazer, Pedro seguiu Jesus sem mais comentários para o que fosse ou viesse. Jesus tinha por objectivo fazer de São Pedro, o chefe da Sua Igreja, aquele que depois d’Ele iria chefiar a Igreja de Jesus Cristo na terra. Não houve “fumos brancos. Nem a opinião aceitável dos outros Apóstolos, simplesmente a ordem para apascentar o Seu rebanho e para isso entregou-lhe as chaves do Céu empossando-lhe de poder ligar na terra seria ligado no Céu. Foi um cargo muito pesado para um homem que até então só percebia das lides de pescar peixe, passaria a apascentar as ovelhas do Senhor, iria arquitectar e expandir a Igreja de Cristo na terra, Esse Pedro que Jesus escolheu para chefiar a Sua Igreja e cuidar do Seu rebanho era o mesmo Pedro que O negaria por três vezes quando Jesus estava no pretória a ser interrogado por Pilatos. A, sabida impetuosidade de Pedro por vezes o deixou em ser severamente criticado por Jesu, e talvez por essa impetuosidade Jesus lhe confiou as chaves do Reino. São Paulo, ainda nos nossos dias, é considerado o Apóstolos dos gentios, Este uma vez convertido, ao cristianismo, percebeu que Jesus Cristo queria que a Sua Palavra fosse expandida e divulgada por toda a terra. Para Paulo ser ou não ciscuncidade era irrelevante, O Evangelho de Cristo para ele tinha que ser assível a toda a gente, a todas as raças, a homens e mulheres com o desejo de aderirem á mensagem de amor que Deus tem para o homem mesmo cá neste mundo. A paixão e zelo pela mensagem de Jesus Cristo, lecou São Paulo a deixar o judaísmo e a perseguição dos cristãos para depois da conversão defender-los e pregar-lhes o Evangelho de Cristo, revelando-lhes a sua própria conversão, Ainda nos nossos dias a maior parte das Segundas Leituras que usamos nas missas dominicais são das cartas que Paulo deixou aos novos cristãos de Corinto, aos hebreus, aos romanos, aos galatas e até mesmo seus discípulos como foi no caso da sua carta a Tito.

São Pedro, São Paulo; são estes dois Apóstolos, os dois pilares principais da Igreja que pertencemos, a Igreja Católica. Esta Solenidade dedicada a estes dois santos, só acontece quando o dia 29 de Junho acontece a ser num Domingo, do mesmo modo que também este modelo acontece quando celebramos São João Baptista e o dia 24 de Junho acontece cair num Domingo. Esses três santos que celebramos em Junho; todos eles merecem da parte da nossa Igreja serem celebrados no Domingo próprio, As liturgias do Tempo Comum param para que a celebração destes três santos seja merecidamente feita e solenemente celebrada por todos nós. A história desses dois santos revela-nos que tal como Jesus morreu crucificado numa cruz, os mesmos, tiveram a mesma morte, testemunhando até ao seu final em serem verdadeiros seguidores de Jesus Cristo e pilares do seu alicerce em Jesus Cristo como deles a Igreja pode crescer e desenvolver-se neste mundo.

Na nossa cultura Portuguesa, S. Pedro pertence ao grupo dos Santos Populares do mês de Junho em: Santo António, S. João e S. Pedro. Enquanto os dois primeiros Santos são celebrados fora do contexto pelo qual eles são hoje reverenciados nos nossos al;tares com marchas, danças ou bailinhos, já no caso de São Pedro por várias paróquias este Santo é especialmente celebrado acarinhadamente pelos pescadores e suas famílias. Era a imagem deste Santo levada em andor para o porto dos barcos de pesca para depois ser este barco todo engalanado com enfeites de papeis coloridos e flores para depois serlançado ao mar seguido pelas outras embarcações com o acostumado entusiasmo dos pescadores a darem viveas ao Senhor S. Pedro!

Um Santo e alegre Domingo da Solenidade de São Pedro e São Paulo para todos!!


Creation Care Tips



We have just passed the summer solstice—the day with the most daylight hours in the northern hemisphere—and we will continue to enjoy long hours of sunlight for weeks to come. This is the perfect time to test out a new invention which has just hit the market. It's both ecological and economical. It replaces the dryer during the summer and is more gentle on clothing. It makes clothes smell fresh, like the outdoors. It's called lateral garment suspension...or more commonly known as "the clothesline." In addition to the ecological aspects, hanging out your laundry is good exercise for the arms, it's relaxing, and it's an opportunity to talk to the neighbors. When it's windy, the result is better than ironing. Look for a space to stretch a laundry line—something permanent or retractable—or get a simple, fold-up drying rack to set up in the sun. You may discover you enjoy the few quiet minutes of hanging laundry outside and the fresh smell so much that you find a way to do it at other times throughout the year, not just when the summer days are at their longest. © The Pastoral Center / PastoralCenter.com. La Iglesia tiene en tanta estima a los santos Pedro y Pablo que su festividad prevalece sobre la principal fiesta semanal del Domingo, el domingo.

Sus caminos no fueron paralelos; Pedro siguió a Jesús desde el principio, fue elegido por el Señor para ser «la roca sobre la que edificaré mi iglesia». Este es el mismo hombre que negó conocer a Jesús al ser interrogado, coincidiendo con el juicio y la condena del Señor.

Pablo, por otro lado, se autodenomina «un prematuro», porque su primer encuentro con Jesús fue en el camino a Damasco, donde viajaba para condenar a los creyentes en el Señor. Recordamos que cuando Esteban fue apedreado, Pablo (o Saulo, como se le llamaba entonces) estaba presente y aprobó la lapidación.

Pedro era probablemente un campesino y Pablo un hombre culto y ciudadano de Roma.

Solo en el plan de Dios pudieron estas personas de orígenes tan diversos convertirse en dos de los líderes más destacados de los primeros tiempos de la Iglesia, acertadamente llamada «la Iglesia Apostólica».

Al celebrar nuestras raíces, vemos en la obra de estos dos y de los demás apóstoles la misión que se nos ha encomendado: ser fieles a la palabra de Dios y predicarla con nuestra forma de vida, para así seguir edificando la Iglesia entre nosotros, trabajando siempre por nutrir la venida del Reino de Dios.

Corresponsabilidad Semanal/Mensual/Anual

“Corresponsabilidad” puede significar muchas cosas para nosotros. Entre ellas se encuentra el cuidado de lo que se nos ha confiado, como “administrar el don de la creación”.

En español, corresponsabilidad es la palabra que se usa para traducir corresponsabilidad.

La corresponsabilidad es la esencia de la corresponsabilidad que se nos exige. Es una responsabilidad compartida por el bien común. En el caso de nuestra parroquia, la responsabilidad financiera recae en cada miembro. No es justo depender de unos pocos para que cuidemos a los demás. Cada uno es responsable, según sus posibilidades, de hacer lo que pueda.

Como se ha compartido en las últimas semanas, no alcanzamos el presupuesto para nuestros ingresos semanales (actualmente \$10,100 por semana).
