



From Monsignor Fran

There are many readings that can be chosen for our Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed (All Souls Day). An Old Testament reading that is often chosen for Funeral Masses is from the Book of Wisdom. It gives hope and consolation:

The souls of the just are in the hands of God and no torment shall touch them. They seemed in the view of the foolish to be dead. . . But they are in peace
(Wisdom 3:1, 2a, 3b).

From Saint Paul, another passage that expresses our faith:

We do not want you to be unaware, brothers and sisters, about those who have fallen asleep, so that you may not grieve like the rest, who have no hope. For if we believe that Jesus died and rose, so too will God, through Jesus, bring with him those who have fallen asleep (1 Thessalonians 4:13-14).

As we celebrate the Feast of All Saints (November 1) and All Souls Day (November 2), we offer God prayers for all the dead, those who are named as saints, the countless and nameless who share the glory of heaven, our beloved dead and those whom no one remembers. Through the mystery of the dying and rising of Christ, we are all connected. Every time we celebrate the Eucharist, we remember and pray for all who have died in these or similar words:

Remember our brothers and sisters who have fallen asleep in the peace of your Christ, and all the dead, whose faith you alone have known. Admit them to rejoice in the light of your face, and in the resurrection give them the fullness of life (from *Eucharistic Prayers for Various Needs*).

Book of the Names of the Dead

Until the beginning of Advent on November 30, the *Book of the Names of the Dead* and Easter Candle will remain near the sanctuary, to encourage you to write the names of those you would like remembered at our Masses throughout November. Traditional All Souls Envelopes will also be available as another way to list the names of the people to be included in our prayer.

Fiftieth Anniversary Celebration of our Portuguese Community at Saint Clare Parish

Next Saturday evening, November 8, we will celebrate a bilingual (English/Portuguese) Mass at 5:00 pm, to commemorate the Fiftieth Anniversary of the founding of the Portuguese Community at Saint Clare Parish.

We invite all to come to this momentous event. We are most fortunate that our Newly-Ordained Auxiliary Bishop Andy Ligot is able to be the main celebrant at the Mass, just five days after his ordination.

Collection for the Archdiocese of Military Services

Our parish will take up the Collection for the Archdiocese for the Military Services, USA (AMS), next weekend, a collection approved by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops to be taken every three years. The AMS provides pastoral care to Catholic men and women serving in the U.S. Armed Forces, enrolled at a U.S. Military Academy, being treated as a patient at any of the 153 U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Centers, or who work for the federal government beyond U.S. borders - including those from our own parish and diocese. The AMS does not receive any funding from the government or military, and has no parishes from which to receive a weekly assessment. Assim rezamos pelas almas do Purgatório, pelas almas dos nossos entes queridos, pelas almas dos amigos e até pelas almas daqueles que ninguém por eles rezam, daqueles que os vivos deles esqueceram. É também a oração usada que o sacerdote faz enquanto incensa o caixão no fim da missa de qualquer funeral. O Dia dos Fieis Defuntos, não é dia de luto e tristeza. É dia de mais íntima comunhão com aqueles que “perdemos”; porque simplesmente os mandamos á nossa frente” É dia de esperança porque sabemos que os nossos irmãos ressurgirão em Cristo para uma vida nova. É, sobretudo, dia de oração que se revestirá de maior significácia,, se a unirmos ao Sacrifício de reconciliação e missa.. Sowing Seeds of Sustainability

\$20,700,000

Behind every vibrant parish, school, and ministry is a web of complex structures and dedicated and faith-filled people, both volunteer and staff. However, many parishes and schools lack the necessary resources for the Church to sustainably minister to its parishioners as Santa Clara County's population and demographics have changed.

It has become clear that the diocese must reimagine the structure of our parishes and schools to better support the vital goal of spiritual renewal outlined in our Pastoral Plan. While we have not concluded yet on what a renewed local structure will look like, this renewal may mean that parishes will collaborate more closely, share resources, or adapt their methods of serving their communities to foster greater vitality and sustainability. Key investments will include:

- Revitalized sacred spaces that enrich liturgy
- Improved parish and school buildings
- Safe, hospitable rectories or living spaces for active and retired clergy
- Enhanced care and support for retired priests
- Adequate and competitively compensated staff for parishes and schools
- A diocesan culture of gratitude and stewardship



How is God calling each of us at Saint Clare Parish to use all that He has entrusted to us to sow seeds of faith for generations to come?




Parish Mission Statement

Hay muchas lecturas que se pueden elegir para nuestra Conmemoración de Todos los Fieles Difuntos (Día de los Fieles Difuntos). Una lectura del Antiguo Testamento que se suele elegir para las Misas de Exequias es del Libro de la Sabiduría. Nos brinda esperanza y consuelo:

Las almas de los justos están en manos de Dios y ningún tormento las alcanzará. A los ojos de los insensatos parecían muertos... Pero están en paz. (Sabiduría 3:1, 2a, 3b).

De San Pablo, otro pasaje que expresa nuestra fe:

Hermanos, no queremos que ignoren lo que sucede con los que han muerto, para que no se entristezcan como los demás, que no tienen esperanza. Porque si creemos que Jesús murió y resucitó, así también Dios, por medio de Jesús, resucitará con él a los que han muerto. (1 Tesalonicenses 4:13-14).

Al celebrar la Fiesta de Todos los Santos (1 de noviembre) y el Día de los Fieles Difuntos (2 de noviembre), elevamos oraciones a Dios por todos los difuntos, por los santos, por los innumerables seres anónimos que comparten la gloria del cielo, por nuestros amados difuntos y por aquellos que nadie recuerda. A través del misterio de la muerte y resurrección de Cristo, todos estamos unidos. Cada vez que celebramos la Eucaristía, recordamos y oramos por todos los que han muerto con estas o similares palabras:

Recuerda a nuestros hermanos y hermanas que han dormido en la paz de tu Cristo, y a todos los difuntos, cuya fe solo tú conociste. Recíbelos con alegría en la luz de tu rostro y, en la resurrección, concédeles la plenitud de la vida (de *Las Oraciones Eucarísticas para Diversas Necesidades*).


