

From Monsignor Fran

Jesus' story goes something like this: "Two people went up to the temple to pray. One did and the other did not." In fact, the tax collector was so aware of his unworthiness, that he stayed in the back row and would not even look toward heaven. He was totally taken with his sinfulness and unworthiness. The Pharisee, on the other hand, sang his own praises to the Lord... "Thank God that I am not like others. . .or this tax collector. . . Thank God that I am better than the rest!"

When we speak to God, let ours be like the prayer of the tax collector, recognizing our faults and praying for God's mercy. As Jesus tells us, it is on account of this kind of honesty that we will be justified: "Whoever exalts oneself will be humbled, and one who humbles oneself will be exalted."

Creation Care Tips



Today we celebrate World Mission Sunday, and this week we celebrate the feast of Saint Anthony of Claret, a Spanish missionary and founder of the religious institute of missionaries known as the Claretians. As the head of the Archdiocese of

Santiago in Cuba, Anthony advocated for family-owned farms for the poor of Cuba, believing that if they produced a variety of foods they could feed their families and sell the rest on the market to become self-sufficient. Your challenge this week is to visit a farmer's market or make a point to buy something from a small, local, family-owned farm rather than buying the supermarket chain store version produced by farms owned by multi-national corporations. Sunday's Responsorial Psalm proclaims that "The Lord hears the cry of the poor." The question is: Do WE hear the cry of those in need—in our families, in our communities, in our country, and even in the world? Or are we too focused on our own issues and worries that we tune out the cries of those around us? Your challenge this week is to listen. Be open to hearing the cries of those who suffer from injustice, hatred, hunger, poverty, loneliness, or whatever might be keeping them from living in hope and joy. Listen to people's stories; listen to the news; just listen. Then choose one voice you have heard and decide how you can reach out and help the person whose cry spoke to your heart. It might be just listening further, or it might be donating time or money. The important thing is that you respond to the cry you have heard. © Center for Ministry Development. 
