

From Monsignor Fran

This final Advent Sunday tells the beginning of the story we know so well: “This is how the birth of Jesus Christ came about. . .” Quoting the prophet Isaiah, which is also our first reading, we hear the familiar words: virgin, son, Emmanuel, God with us.

Sometimes, we romanticize how this came about. We cherish memories about the unexpected expectation of the Lord by Mary and Joseph, of their journey to Bethlehem; we sing carols about the manger, angels and shepherds. But to those who were living these events, it was not all sweetness and light, but wonder, confusion and submission to God’s will.

As we approach Christmas, we have the opportunity once again to welcome into our lives the same Lord. The path for us is no clearer or less treacherous than that of Mary and Joseph, yet we also trust that God is truly with us: Emmanuel.

I recently viewed Kevin Costner’s “The First Christmas,” which is a portrayal of the events leading up to Jesus’ birth. While some explanations of the scriptural account left me wondering, others showed in a realistic way what Mary, Joseph and Jesus may have experienced. It is worth seeing it, and it is currently streaming on Disney and Hulu.



Boletim Paroquial Português; Domingo IV do Advento – Ano A Reflexão por: João Pereira Arruda

Noutros tempos e noutros lugares, celebrava-se o Natal do Emanuel a partir da meia-noite do dia 24 de dezembro, com a tradicional Missa do Galo, a que hoje chamamos de Vigília de Natal, e no dia seguinte várias missas, conforme o tamanho da freguesia, com a Missa da Festa do Natal. Celebrava-se o Natal até à Epifania do Senhor, mais conhecida como o Dia dos Reis Magos. Para pessoas da minha idade era assim; hoje já não é, e as segundas e terceiras gerações ficaram privadas de celebrar o Natal desse modo. Agora celebramos o Natal desde o Dia de Ação de Graças, e praticamente termina no próprio dia 25. As mentalidades de então estavam centradas no nascimento de Jesus, na preparação para O receber nas nossas vidas e nos nossos corações. Alargavam-se os cordões à bolsa para que a família tivesse uma refeição mais melhorada, com algumas farturas a mais, o que depois resultava, mais tarde, em alguns jejuns. Havia grande dedicação em armar presépios, cada qual segundo a imaginação da família. Na preparação espiritual faziam-se esforços para participar nos novenários e nas confissões, o que deixava pouco espaço para o Santa Claus, figura inexistente naquele tempo e lugar, e que hoje se tornou tão preponderante nesta quadra festiva — a maior e mais rendosa para os comércios de qualquer lugar. Esse era o cenário de então, e que continua a trazer saudades à faixa etária da primeira geração. Hoje, com todas as mudanças, o Menino Jesus, nascido e deitado numa manjedoura, provavelmente nasceria num descampado que serve de acampamento aos sem-abrigo, àqueles para quem tanto faz que venha um Menino salvar a humanidade que lhes nega lugar nela. Estes são natais falhos de esperança. Pior ainda são os natais onde existe guerra e violência; enquanto milhões sofrem as consequências da guerra, são vítimas do poder e da ganância de uns poucos que, confortavelmente, celebram o Natal com farturas desnecessárias — farturas essas que fazem falta nos acampamentos dos sem-abrigo. É Natal para nós! Um Natal para o qual a nossa paróquia tudo fez para que nos preparássemos para celebrar o Menino Jesus em português, inglês, espanhol, mandarim e cantonês. O Emanuel chega confortavelmente a uma paróquia que espelha, na realidade, o verdadeiro catolicismo.

Que, neste tempo que resta do Advento, tenhamos um coração agradecido pela graça de viver e pertencer a esta paróquia. Agradeçamos pelos sacerdotes e pelo staff responsável pela administração paroquial. Sejam reconhecidos pelas diversas comunidades que aqui convivem, para que o Espírito Santo alimente sempre em todos o desejo de viverem em unidade e amor fraterno.

Oremos para que os esforços e programas feitos para atrair mais jovens deem muito fruto, garantindo a continuidade da nossa fé. Rezemos pelos membros do nosso Conselho Paroquial por todos os seus esforços em coordenar as liturgias na nossa língua. Rezemos também por nós mesmos, para que sejamos invadidos por sentimentos de gratidão por sermos uma família comunitária; e que o Espírito de Deus, especialmente neste Natal, nos torne bondosos uns para com os outros.

Enquanto completamos as orações da Grinalda do Advento — de Esperança, de Fé, de Alegria e de Paz — chegamos à manjedoura do Menino Jesus. Ele é a única razão para celebrarmos o Natal; e, por isso, com alegria dizemos: Feliz Natal!



Close Enough!

It is the fourth Sunday of Advent. When Christmas is this close, one takes that final leap. Isaiah is centuries from Christmas, but he cannot wait! He sees the “sign” as clear as day: “the young woman, pregnant and about to bear a son” (Isaiah 7:14). And how about that Son! None other than “Emmanuel” himself—God-With-Us! Paul, too, is bursting at the seams! Inspired by what he calls “the obedience of faith” (Romans 5), he is excited to see the gospel thriving even among the Gentiles. For him, the “Spirit of holiness” is a gift offered to all—Christmas every day, you might say.

Speaking of “obedience of faith,” Joseph is the perfect example. The word “obey” comes from the same root as “to hear,” and Joseph has almost supernatural ears! Matthew, the former tax collector, tells “how the birth of Jesus Christ came about” in today’s gospel reading like a bookkeeper—the Holy Spirit in Column A, Joseph in Column B, with Mary in the middle. But when an angel whispers to Joseph at night, his dream comes true: “he took his wife into his home.” Everything is set for Emmanuel!

So, the Bible is brimming with Christmas, that is, “God-With-Us,” from end to end. And when a virgin can conceive, are any of us exempt from “birthing” Jesus in our midst? Even when a “happy holiday” seems impossible in the midst of war or violence or poverty, when our ears hear only silence, let’s sing Christmas carols every day! ●

Este último domingo de Adviento nos narra el comienzo de la historia que tan bien conocemos: «Así fue el nacimiento de Jesucristo...». Citando al profeta Isaías, cuya profecía es también nuestra primera lectura, escuchamos las conocidas palabras: virgen, hijo, Emmanuel, Dios con nosotros.

A veces, idealizamos cómo sucedieron estos acontecimientos. Atesoramos los recuerdos de la inesperada espera del Señor por parte de María y José, de su viaje a Belén; cantamos villancicos sobre el pesebre, los ángeles y los pastores. Pero para quienes vivieron estos eventos, no todo fue dulzura y alegría, sino asombro, confusión y sumisión a la voluntad de Dios.

Al acercarnos a la Navidad, tenemos la oportunidad, una vez más, de acoger en nuestras vidas al mismo Señor. El camino para nosotros no es más claro ni menos difícil que el de María y José, pero también confiamos en que Dios está verdaderamente con nosotros: Emmanuel.

Recientemente vi la película de Kevin Costner, «La primera Navidad», que narra los acontecimientos previos al nacimiento de Jesús. Si bien algunas interpretaciones del relato bíblico me dejaron con dudas, otras mostraron de manera realista lo que María, José y Jesús pudieron haber experimentado. Vale la pena verla, y actualmente está disponible en Disney+ y Hulu.
