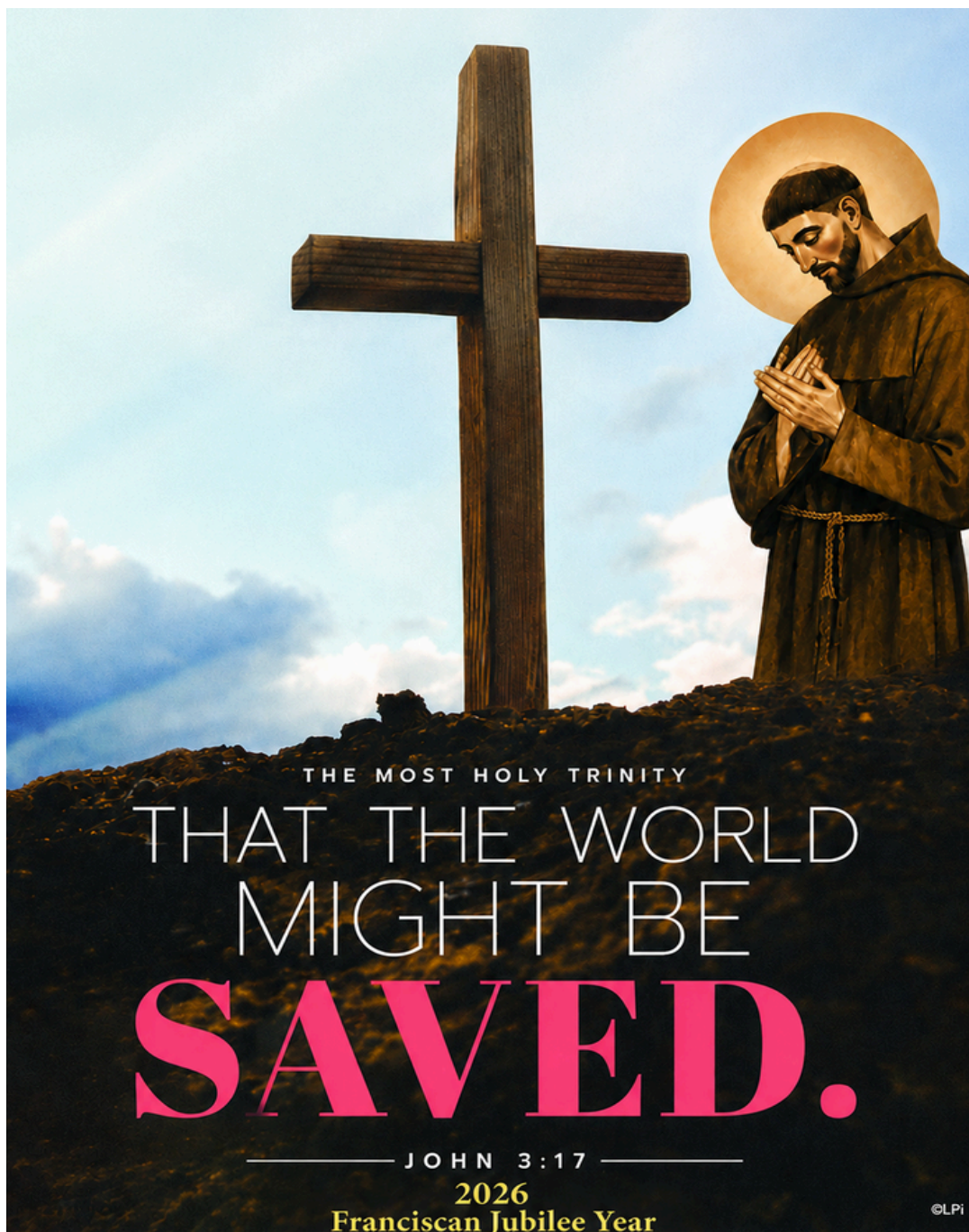

From Monsignor Fran

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity presents us with a wonderful challenge. But the challenge is not to try to **understand** the Trinity, but to **appreciate** the depth of God's love for us and for all creation.

We experience the one God through many lenses: Creator, Redeemer, Sanctifier. . .Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Eternally one, but distinct "persons."

There is an ancient expression: *Lex orandi, lex credendi*. . . Our prayer establishes our faith, what we believe. This is no more visible than in our prayer and belief in the Holy Trinity. We begin our prayers with the Sign of the Cross, invoking the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. In the liturgy, we conclude our prayers, addressed to the Father, "through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with You in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, forever and ever."

And the simplest of prayers is also the deepest: "Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning, is now and will be for ever. Amen.

Finally, faith teaches us that God is close to us, living within each of us. Remembering this gives us encouragement to see in one another this living presence of God.

Weekly Justice Challenges



Today we celebrate a mystery—the mystery that is the Most Holy Trinity, three Persons yet one God. The Trinity exists in perfect communion and community as Father, Son and Spirit. God doesn't just give perfect love—God is Love, and that love reveals itself in the relationship of Father, Son and Spirit. Your challenge this week is to make the connection between love and justice. As Pope Benedict wrote in *Caritas in Veritate*, “Love — caritas — is an extraordinary force which leads people to opt for courageous and generous engagement in the field of justice and peace. It is a force that has its origin in God, Eternal Love and Absolute Truth.” Reflect this week on the following questions (as individuals and as families): “How does God’s love for us compel us to take action to fight injustice? Who needs our love the most this week—in the family, in our community, and in our world? How can we share our love? Is it through service, advocacy, financial support or something else?” Select one way of living justice through the lens of love—and do it!

Creative Care

Pope Benedict said, “Purchasing is always a moral—and not simply economic—act.” What things do you purchase that have a disproportionate environmental footprint?

Bananas shipped from South America? Clothing manufactured in Asia? Tissues made from the wood of boreal forests in Canada? Choose one item you can do without and boycott the purchase of that item. 31 de Maio de 2026 – Domingo da Solenidade da Santíssima Trindade
Reflexão por: João Pereira Arruda

Ao longo dos tempos, muitos doutores da Igreja procuraram explicar este mistério. Contudo, tal como os mistérios da Encarnação e da Eucaristia, a Santíssima Trindade não pode ser plenamente compreendida pela razão humana; é um mistério acolhido pela fé.

A vida dos cristãos, e particularmente dos católicos, centra-se neste mistério: Deus é uno e trino — três Pessoas distintas num só Deus verdadeiro. Todas as Missas começam com o sinal da cruz, o sinal que identifica o cristão: “Em nome do Pai, e do Filho, e do Espírito Santo.”

Também antigamente, ao toque das Avé-Marias ou das Trindades, os fiéis descobriam a cabeça e faziam devotamente o sinal da cruz: tocando a testa ao pronunciar “Em nome do Pai”; o peito, ao dizer “e do Filho”; e os ombros, ao dizer “e do Espírito Santo”.

O mistério da Santíssima Trindade reflete-se também no sacramento do Matrimónio. Nas alianças trocadas pelos esposos está o compromisso do amor fiel e a presença de Jesus Cristo nessa união sacramental. Com a ajuda de Cristo, o casal forma uma família cristã que, através dos filhos, dá continuidade à Igreja neste mundo.

Damos graças a todos os que, ao longo destes 130 anos, contribuíram para a continuidade desta Sociedade e para que o seu edifício permanecesse um centro de acolhimento para outras organizações de índole religiosa, como as celebrações de Santo António, Santa Cecília e Nossa Senhora de Fátima.

Rezemos pelas almas de todos os sócios falecidos que ajudaram esta Sociedade a crescer, e peçamos saúde e dedicação aos seus dirigentes, para que continuem unidos no amor fraterno e no serviço à comunidade.

O Conselho Paroquial Português congratula os membros diretivos desta Sociedade e agradece a sua presença celebrativa conosco nesta Missa dedicada ao Espírito Santo, a Terceira Pessoa da Santíssima Trindade.

Que as festividades desta efeméride sejam abençoadas e bem-sucedidas, e que todos nós, como comunidade, continuemos a apoiar e a celebrar esta tão querida tradição portuguesa.

Embracing the Mystery

FR. THOMAS M. SANTA, CSSR


The Christian confession of a triune God cannot be explained, it can only be believed. It is not a cop-out to proclaim that this belief is rooted in mystery. Mystery is the essential language and experience of belief. We lose something when we try to explain a mystery instead of embracing it. It may make us uncomfortable; it may provoke more questions than answers. Regardless, it does not suggest the weakness of mystery but rather the beauty, the wonder, and the awe.

Embracing belief and living as a person of faith is a singular journey. You cannot believe for someone else, and that person, even one you dearly love, cannot believe for you. It is also important to understand that as singular as the journey of faith may be, it ultimately ends in community. Belief does not isolate a person, but rather invites a person to connect with others who also walk in faith.

The community/communion of the triune God—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit—is the perfect witness to the truth that mystery creates. One God, three divine persons. The Eucharist that we celebrate on this day proclaims the unity of our belief—to the Father, through the Son, by the power of the Holy Spirit. ●

Abrazar el misterio

La confesión cristiana de un Dios trino no se puede explicar, solo se puede creer. No es una excusa proclamar que esta creencia tiene sus raíces en el misterio. El misterio es el lenguaje y la experiencia esenciales de la fe. Perdemos algo cuando intentamos explicar un misterio en lugar de abrazarlo. Puede que nos resulte incómodo; puede que provoque más preguntas que respuestas. Sin embargo, eso no sugiere la debilidad del misterio, sino más bien su belleza, su maravilla y su asombro.

Aceptar la creencia y vivir como una persona de fe es un viaje singular. No se puede creer por otra persona y esa persona, incluso alguien a quien se ama profundamente, no puede creer por uno mismo. También es importante comprender que, por muy singular que sea el viaje de la fe, en última instancia termina en comunidad. La creencia no aísla a una persona, sino que la invita a conectarse con otras personas que también caminan en la fe.

La comunidad/comunión del Dios trino —Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo— es el testimonio perfecto de la verdad que crea el misterio. Un solo Dios, tres personas divinas. La Eucaristía que celebramos en este día proclama la unidad de nuestra creencia: al Padre, por medio del Hijo, por el poder del Espíritu Santo. ●

Experimentamos al único Dios a través de muchas dimensiones: Creador, Redentor, Santificador... Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo. Eternamente uno, pero personas distintas.

Existe una antigua expresión: *Lex orandi, lex credendi*... nuestra oración establece nuestra fe, aquello que creemos. Esto se hace especialmente visible en nuestra oración y creencia en la Santísima Trinidad. Comenzamos nuestras oraciones con la Señal de la Cruz, invocando al Padre, al Hijo y al Espíritu Santo. En la liturgia, concluimos nuestras oraciones, dirigidas al Padre, “por nuestro Señor Jesucristo, tu Hijo, que vive y reina contigo en la unidad del Espíritu Santo y es Dios por los siglos de los siglos.”
