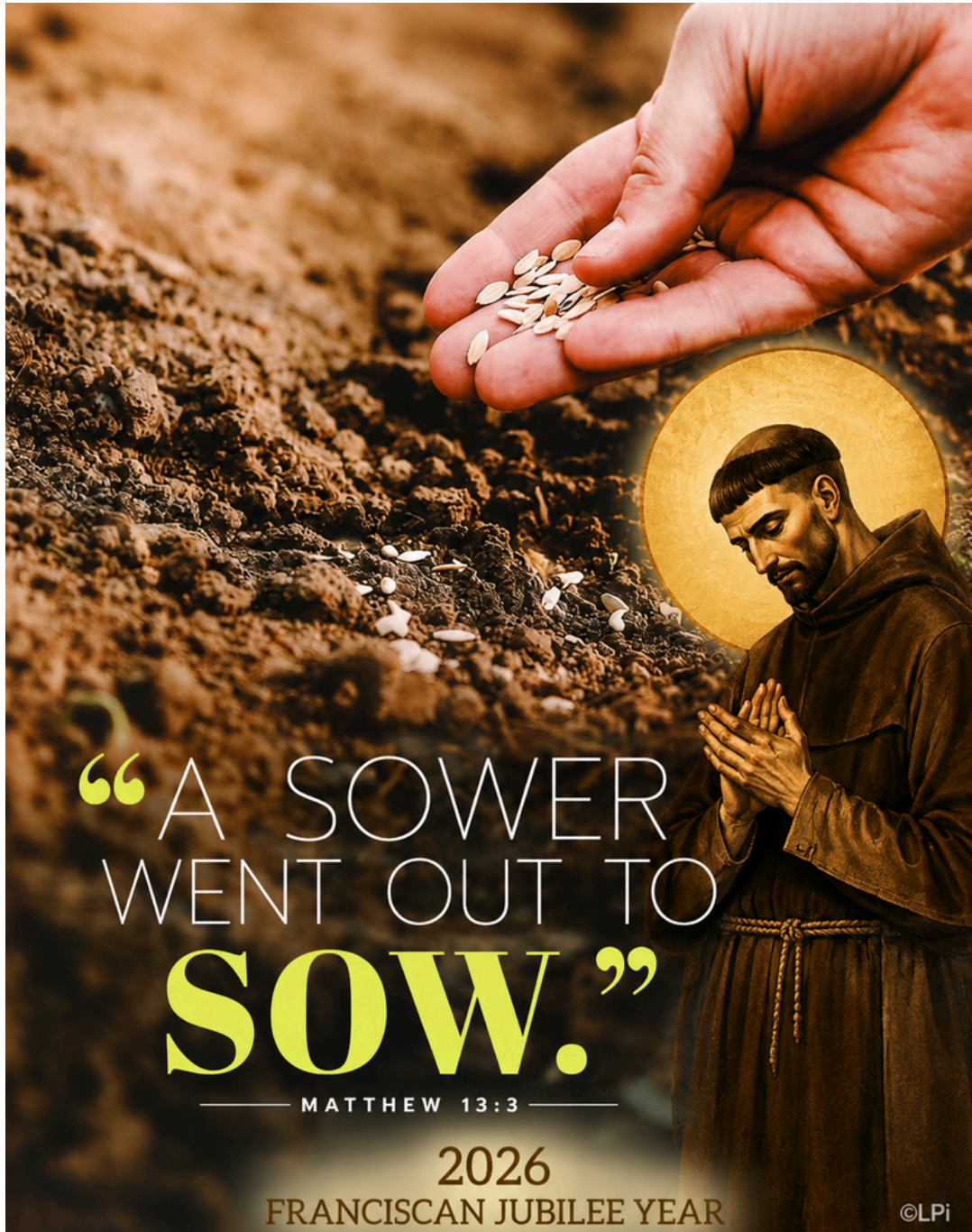

## Introductory Message from New Pastor Rev. Joseph Mendie Nguyen

Greetings, brothers and sisters of Saint Clare!

It is a joy and a blessing to greet you as I begin my ministry as your new Pastor. My name is Father Joseph Mendie Nguyen, though I simply go by Father Mendie, as there are many priests named Joseph in our Diocese of San José.

I am truly humbled and grateful for the opportunity to serve the Saint Clare Parish and School community. I would like to express my heartfelt gratitude to Msgr. Fran Cilia for his guidance and for ensuring a smooth transition. I wish him every blessing in his new ministry as Rector of the Cathedral Basilica of Saint Joseph. I am also delighted to be reunited with Msgr. Francisco Rios, with whom I had the privilege of serving at Saint Catherine of Alexandria in Morgan Hill.

Allow me to share a little about myself. I was born and raised in South Vietnam and immigrated to the United States in 1991. Before entering seminary, I worked in a variety of occupations. In the spring of 2006, I entered the Divine Word Missionaries before continuing my priestly formation for the Diocese of San José at Saint Patrick Seminary & University in Menlo Park.

Following my ordination to the priesthood on June 1, 2013, I served as Parochial Vicar at Saint Simon Parish in Los Altos for six years, then at Saint Joseph Parish in Cupertino from 2019 to 2023, and most recently at Saint Catherine of Alexandria in Morgan Hill from 2023 until my appointment as Pastor of Saint Clare.

Since learning of my assignment, I have been praying for this parish and for each of you. From my very first weekend here, I have already experienced the warmth, kindness, and generosity that make Saint Clare such a vibrant faith community. Thank you for the gracious welcome you have extended to me.

My hope is that together we will continue to grow as a parish rooted in Christ, strengthened by the Eucharist, and inspired to live the Gospel through faith, love, and service. I look forward to getting to know each of you, hearing your stories, accompanying you on your faith journey, and working together to build an even stronger parish family.

If we have not yet had the opportunity to meet, I warmly invite you to introduce yourself after Mass. It will be a joy to get to know you, and I ask for your continued prayers as we begin this new chapter together.

May God bless you and your families, and may the intercession of Saint Clare guide us as we walk together in faith.

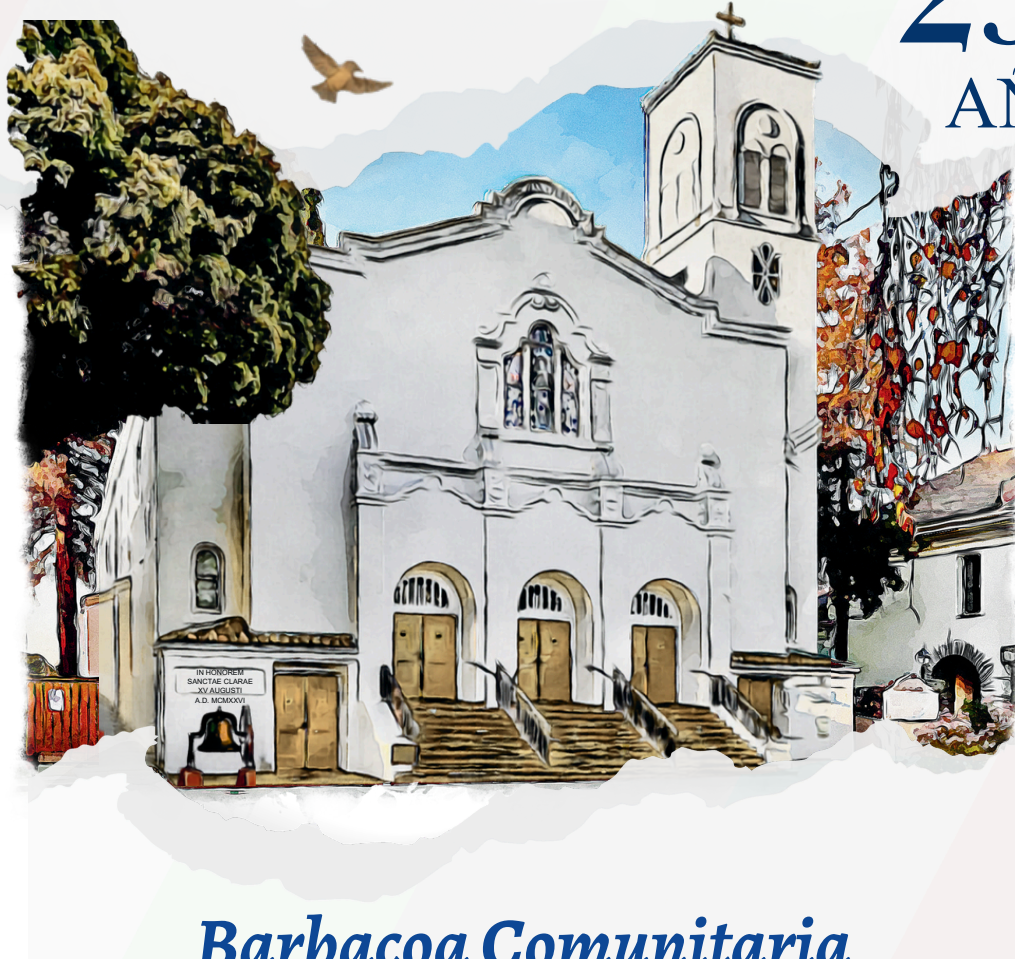

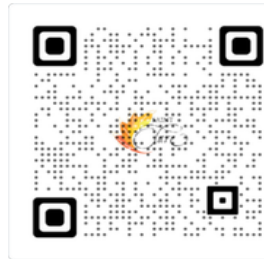
