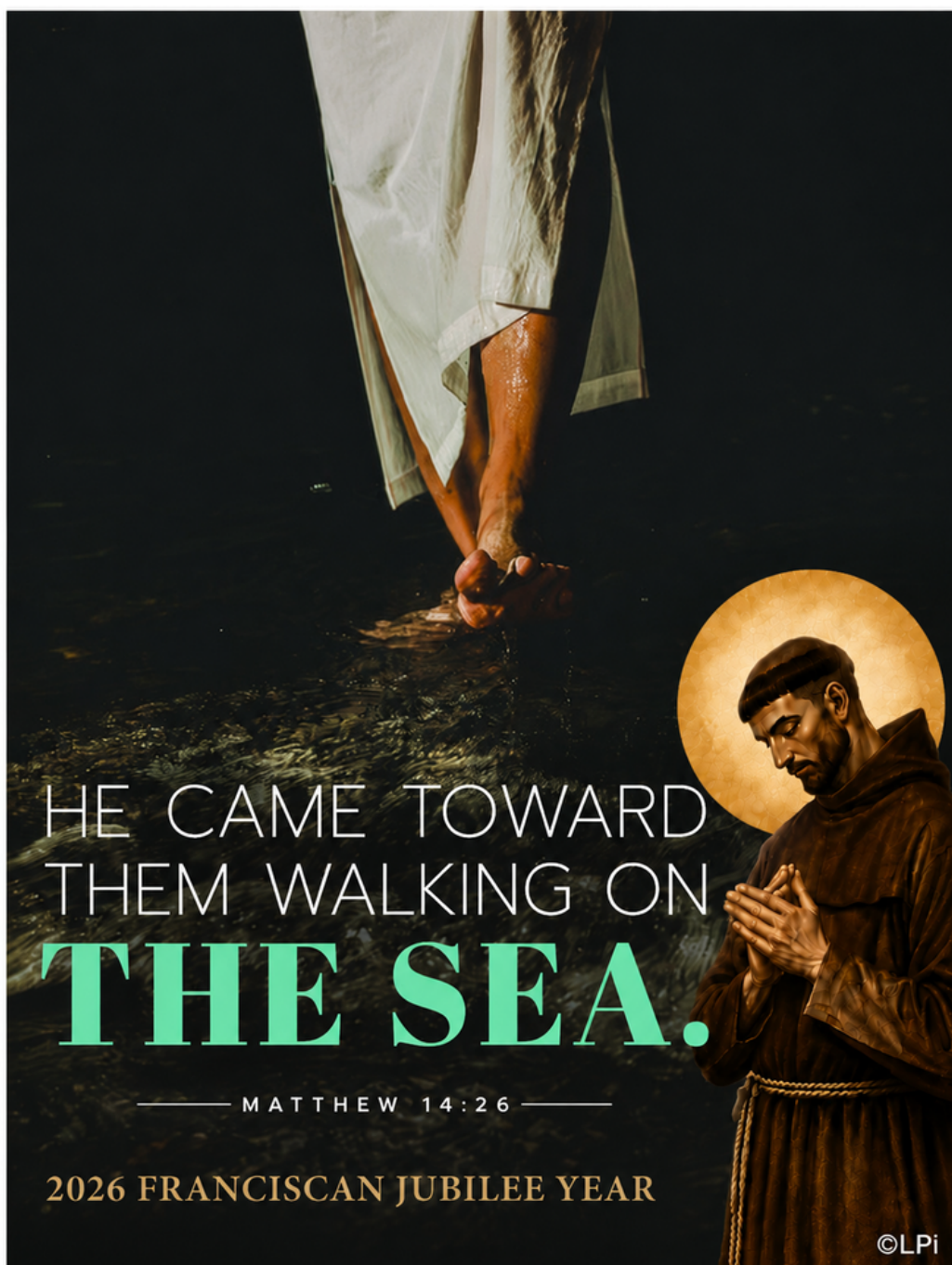

Order of Christian Initiation of Adults

Are you thinking about becoming Catholic?

God works in many different ways. Most of the time, God works through ordinary people and events—a parent, a friend, a beautiful sunset, a song, an inspiring story. Other times, we hear God's call during crisis moments or major life-changes—a birth, an engagement, a sickness, a death. Sometimes, we just have a feeling that something is missing. No matter what your reason for thinking about becoming Catholic, our hope and prayer is that when God calls, you will respond. (If you're reading this, you've already begun to respond!) One part of the Catholic Church's mission is to help people respond to God as best they can.

For Christians, initiation and on-going participation in the life of the Church are the primary responses to God's call. Through the process of becoming Catholic, we try to help people learn how to respond to that call not just for the moment of baptism but for every day of their lives. The way we learn how to respond is by actually doing what Catholics do. So, the process of becoming Catholic is not so much about learning things as in a classroom but learning a way of life as an apprentice learns from a master and that master's community.

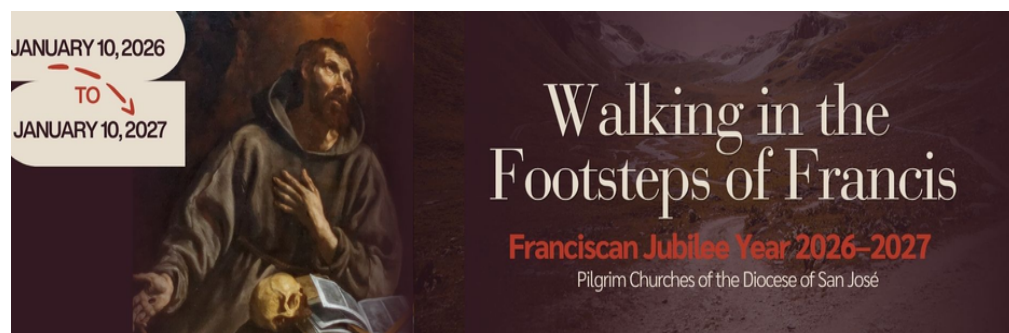

Maybe you are called to give up television to help someone with their homework, or to sacrifice a meal in order to pray for a loved one suffering from cancer. It might be taking money you saved for a smart phone or tablet and donating it to people suffering from a hurricane or typhoon. What are you willing to give up for others?

Nos últimos três domingos, temos escutado, na Liturgia da Palavra, Jesus a descrever-nos o Reino de Deus. Falava em parábolas para que aqueles que O ouviam pudessem compreender melhor e visualizar esse Reino que o Pai preparou para cada um de nós. Mais ainda, ensina-nos que, para alcançarmos esse Reino, é necessária uma decisão radical: não nos deixarmos prender pelas ofertas deste mundo nem pelas tentações do maligno, mas concentrarmo-nos na vontade de Deus, amando-O através do amor aos nossos irmãos.

Esta mensagem encontra um belo testemunho na vida da nossa padroeira, Santa Clara de Assis. A sua vida, marcada pela fé e pela entrega total a Cristo, continua a iluminar o nosso caminho. Enquanto para muitos seria impensável abandonar uma vida de nobreza e riqueza para abraçar a pobreza, Santa Clara fez essa escolha com alegria, entregando-se inteiramente ao Senhor.

Santa Clara foi também a primeira mulher na história da Igreja a escrever uma regra de vida para uma comunidade feminina. Nessa Regra estabeleceu princípios fundamentais para as suas irmãs, mostrando com clareza o que significa viver segundo o Evangelho de Jesus Cristo. Dois pilares ocupam um lugar central no seu projeto de vida: a pobreza evangélica e a vida fraterna em comunidade.

Tal como São Francisco de Assis, cuja memória jubilar dos oitocentos anos continuamos a celebrar, Santa Clara abraçou a pobreza como caminho de identificação com Cristo pobre e humilde, reconhecendo n'Ele o seu único Esposo e Senhor.

Como paroquianos desta comunidade, dedicada a Santa Clara há 250 anos, temos razões muito fortes para celebrar com alegria e gratidão a nossa padroeira, uma das grandes santas da Igreja.

Entre os muitos milagres que lhe são atribuídos, destacam-se três: Primeiro: já muito debilitada pela doença, Santa Clara tomou nas mãos a custódia com o Santíssimo Sacramento e dirigiu-se às muralhas do convento. Os soldados que cercavam o mosteiro retiraram-se, permitindo que as irmãs continuassem a viver em paz a sua vida de oração e contemplação.

Segundo: quando havia apenas um pão para alimentar cinquenta irmãs clarissas, Santa Clara mandou dividi-lo. Apesar da surpresa de quem recebeu essa ordem, o pão multiplicou-se, chegando para todas as religiosas.

Terceiro: certa ocasião, o convento ficou sem azeite e não havia dinheiro para o comprar. Santa Clara mandou lavar cuidadosamente o jarro vazio e colocá-lo junto ao portão. Quando o criado foi buscá-lo, encontrou-o completamente cheio de azeite, para espanto de todos.

Estes milagres nasceram da profunda união de Santa Clara com Jesus Cristo. A sua vida foi inteiramente dedicada à oração, à contemplação e à adoração de Cristo presente na Santíssima Eucaristia. Por amor ao Senhor, deixou para trás os privilégios de uma família nobre e abraçou uma vida de humildade, pobreza e serviço.

Como comunidade portuguesa, unamo-nos às restantes comunidades e grupos da nossa paróquia para celebrarmos, em verdadeira comunhão, a festa da nossa padroeira. Que todos participemos nas celebrações religiosas, culturais e sociais preparadas pelo Conselho Pastoral, fortalecendo os laços de fraternidade e testemunhando a unidade da nossa comunidade.
